MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

Small and Medium (foot length can be adjusted as required)

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Alegria Grande (75% superwash Merino/25% Polyamide), 180m/197yds per 100g,
1 x 100g hank
Shown in #8726 Carnaval
1 set of 4mm (US #6) double pointed needles (set of 5)
Stitch marker
Tapestry needle
Tape measure

TENSION

20 sts and 28 rows in a 10cm (4in) square over stocking stitch using 4mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

K: knit

P: purl

St(s): stitch(es)

Dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)

P2tog: purl 2 together

Sl: slip stitch

Pssso: pass slipped stitch over

INSTRUCTIONS

Make both alike

Leg

Cast on 40 sts loosely.

Divide stitches over 4 dpns with 10 sts on each needle. Being careful not to twist sts, join in the round, placing stitch marker at beginning of the round. Slip marker at the end of every round.

Rounds 1 to 18 (RS): (K1, p1) to end of round.

Continue to knit in rounds in stocking stitch, until leg measures 16cm (6.5in) from the cast-on edge, ending after working needle 4.

Heel

Slip 10 sts from 1st needle and 10 sts from 4th needle together onto one needle (and remove st marker in the middle) - 20 sts now on one dpn.

Continue working back and forth in rows on this dpn.

Leave out the sts from needles 2 and 3; these sts will be the instep (top of foot) and will not be worked until the heel flap and turn are complete.

Row 1 (WS): Sl1, purl to end of row, turn.

Row 2: (Sl1, k1) to end of row, turn.

Repeat last 2 rows until heel measures 5cm (2in) ending with wrong side facing for next row.

Turn Heel

Row 1 (WS): P13, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 2 (RS): Sl1, k7, sl1, k1, pssso k1, turn.

Row 3: Sl1, p8, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 4: Sl1, k9, sl1, k1, pssso, k1, turn.

Row 5: Sl1, p10, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 6 (RS): Sl1, k11, sl1, k1, pssso, k1. (14 sts).

Slip last 7 sts worked onto spare dpn (this is now needle 1). With right side facing, pick up and knit 10 sts up left side of heel. Knit across 10 sts on 2nd needle and 10 sts on 3rd needle. Pick up and knit 10 sts down right side of heel, ending with knitting 7 stitches from heel. (54 sts)

Place stitch marker to mark the new start of the round and continue working rounds as follows:

Round 1: (1st needle) knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1, (2nd needle) knit to end, (3rd needle) knit to end, (4th needle) k1, sl1, k1, pssso, knit to end of needle – 2 sts decreased.

Round 2: Knit.

Repeat last 2 rounds 6 times more to leave 10 sts on each needle. (40 sts)

Knit in rounds until foot measures required length (leaving 4cm (1.5in) for toe) ending with 4th needle.

Shape Toe

Round 1: (1st needle) knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1, (2nd needle) k1, sl1, k1 pssso, knit to end, (3rd needle) knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1, (4th needle) k1, sl1, k1, pssso knit to end – 4 sts decreased.

Round 2: Knit.

Repeat last 2 rounds 4 times more. (5 sts remain on each needle)

Place sts from needle 1 and needle 4 together onto one needle, and sts from needle 2 and 3 together onto one needle. (10 sts on each needle).

Break yarn leaving a 25cm (10in) tail.

With tapestry needle and yarn end, graft remaining 2 sets of 10 sts together to close toe, using Kitchener stitch. Weave in all ends.
