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## Fiesta Scarf in Manos del Uruguay Franca

### SIZE

183cm/72" long x 30.5cm/12" wide (excluding fringe)

### MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay FRANCA (100% superwash merino; approx. 105m/114 yds) per 150g, 2 skeins each C1 and C3, plus 3 skeins C2

Shown in FR23 Velvet (C1), FR9904 Hule (C2) and FR01 Miel (C3)

9mm (US 13) needle, or size to obtain tension  
Tapestry needle  
6.5mm crochet hook (for fringe)

### TENSION

13 sts = 10cm /4" over 1 x 1 Rib, relaxed

### STITCH GUIDE

1 x 1 Rib (even number of stitches)  
Row 1: (K1, p1) across  
Rep Row 1 for 1 x 1 Rib

### ABBREVIATIONS

**C1:** colour 1  
**C2:** colour 2  
**C3:** colour 3  
**k:** knit  
**p:** purl  
**rep:** repeat  
**st(s):** stitch(es)

### NOTE:

Each stripe is worked over an odd number of rows so that the join with the next colour isn't always at the same edge. When weaving in ends, work down a column of sts rather than across a row, to keep the scarf maximally reversible.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Using C1, cast on 52 sts. Work in 1x1 Rib for 42 rows  
Cut yarn; join C2 and work in 1x1 Rib for 43 rows  
Cut yarn; join C3 and work in 1x1 Rib for 86 rows



Cut yarn; join C2 and work in 1x1 Rib for 43 rows  
Cut yarn; join C1 and work in 1x1 Rib for 42 rows  
Next row: Cast off in pattern.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

### FRINGE

Fringe is created by attaching 1 strand of fringe in every other st at each end of scarf  
Using C2, cut 52 pieces of fringe, each 40cm/16" long.  
At the bottom edge of the scarf, insert the crochet hook from back to front  
Hook the midpoint of the two strands of fringe, and pull them through 5cm/2"  
Insert the ends through this new loop and pull them snug  
Repeat in every other st at each end of scarf  
Trim ends of fringe even.
