MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

190cm long x 58cm at widest point

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Milo (65% Merino / 35% Linen),
350m/382yds per 100g)

1 skein each of MC and CC

Shown in MI2342 Conifera (MC) and MI7049 Cadaques
(CC)

3.75mm (US 5) 60cm circular needle, or size needed to
obtain gauge

Locking stitch marker

Tapestry needle

TENSION

14 sts and 20 rows in 10cm square in Brioche Stitch, after
blocking (remember that Row 1A + Row 1B = one Brioche
row)

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: beginning

BO: cast off

bri: work (k, yo, k) all into next st together with its
yarnover (2 sts increased) On the following row, these sts
will be worked as (yfslyo, k1, yfslyo).

brk: knit together the next stitch and its yarnover

brk3tog: knit together the next 3 sts plus the yarnovers on
the first and third (2 sts decreased)

brp: purl together the next stitch and its yarnover

brskp: slip the next st plus its yarnover knitwise, knit
together the following 2 sts plus the yarnover on the
second, pass the slipped st and its yarnover over (2 sts
decreased)

CO: cast on

dec: decrease

inc: increase

K: knit

M: marker

ndl: needle

p: purl

rep: repeat

sl: slip

slyrn: with yarn in front, slip next stitch, then bring yarn over
needle and around to the front of the work again

st(s): stitch(es)

wyib: with yarn in back

wyif: with yarn in front

yfslyo: bring yarn to front of work, slip next stitch, then
bring yarn over needle to back of work

yo: yarnover



STITCH GUIDE

Note: Except for Row 1B, all of these pattern stitches are the same. Row 1B differs for each.

Plain Pattern (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1A: With CC, sl1 wyib, (brp, slyrn) to last 2 sts, brp, sl1 wyib. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Row 1B Plain: With MC, sl1 wyib, (yfslyo, brk) to last 2 sts, yfslyo, k1. Turn work

Row 2A: With CC, sl1 wyif, (brk, yfslyo) to last 2 sts, brk, sl1 wyif. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Row 2B: With MC, sl1 wyif, (slyrn, brp) to last 2 sts, slyrn, p1

Turn work

Rep rows 1A through 2B for Plain Pattern

Increase Pattern (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1A: With CC, sl1 wyib, (brp, slyrn) to last 2 sts, brp, sl1 wyib. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Row 1B Increase: With MC, sl1 wyib, (yfslyo, brk) to 3 sts before marked centre st, yfslyo, bri, yfslyo, brk, yfslyo, bri, (yfslyo, brk) to last 2 sts, yfslyo, k1. Turn work. 4 sts increased

Row 2A: With CC, sl1 wyif, (brk, yfslyo) to last 2 sts, brk, sl1 wyif. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Row 2B: With MC, sl1 wyif, (slyrn, brp) to last 2 sts, slyrn, p1. Turn work

Rep rows 1A through 2B for Increase Pattern

Bias Pattern (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1A: With CC, sl1 wyib, (brp, slyrn) to last 2 sts, brp, sl1 wyib. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Row 1B Bias: With MC, sl1 wyib, yfslyo, brskp, (yfslyo, brk) to 3 sts before marked centre st, yfslyo, bri, yfslyo, brk, yfslyo, bri, (yfslyo, brk) to last 6 sts, yfslyo, brk3tog, yfslyo, k1. Turn work

Row 2A: With CC, sl1 wyif, (brk, yfslyo) to last 2 sts, brk, sl1 wyif. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work.

Row 2B: With MC, sl1 wyif, (slyrn, brp) to last 2 sts, slyrn, p1. Turn work

Rep rows 1A through 2B for Bias Pattern

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, CO 13 sts.

Set-up row: Join CC. Sl1 wyif, (k1, yfslyo) 5 times, k1, sl1 wyif. Slide sts to other end of ndl; do not turn work

Next row: With MC, work Row 2B. Turn work and place locking stitch marker on center st. (Move it up every few inches so the centre st is always clear)

Work Pattern Stitch in this sequence:

*1 rep of Increase Pattern, 1 rep of Plain Pattern, (1 rep of Bias Pattern, 1 rep of Plain Pattern) 3 times; rep from *. 4 sts increased

Rep this sequence 19 times more (93 sts), or until desired length

With CC, work Row 1A. Slide sts to other end of ndl. With MC, cast (bind) off as follows: sl1 wyib, *p1, BO old st over new st; brk, BO old st over new st; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, BO old st over new st, k1, BO old st over new st. Cut both yarns and fasten off

FINISHING

Weave in ends; block gently.
