MANOS DEL URUGUAY

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

To fit: XS [S, M, L, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X]

Finished bust: 79 [88, 98, 107, 116, 130, 140, 149]cm to fit with 0-1cm ease

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Milo (65% Merino / 35% Linen), 350m/382yds per 100g)
Shown in MI2156 Venezia 2 [2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3] skeins
1 x 3.5 mm (US 4) circular ndl with 40[40, 40, 40, 50, 50, 50, 50]cm cable
1 x 3.5 mm (US 4) circular ndl with 60[80, 80, 80, 100, 120, 120]cm cable
1 set of 3.5 mm (US 4) dpns
5 stitch markers (1 different colour to show start of round)
2 stitch holders, or waste yarn
Waste yarn for provisional cast on

TENSION

24 sts and 32 rows measured over 10 cm x 10cm

HINTS AND TIPS

Difficulty: Intermediate (provisional cast on, working in round on small diameters and placing stitches on stitch holder)

Due to the number of sizes, it is advisable to circle your size before you start knitting.

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: begin
cont: continue
dec: decrease
dpns: double pointed needles
inc: increase
g-st: garter stitch
k: knit
k2tog: knit next 2 sts together (1 stitch decreased)
k2 tog tbl: knit 2 together through back loop
LH: left hand
pm: place marker
p: purl
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip
sm: slip marker
sts: stitches
st st: stocking stitch
WS: wrong side
yo: yarnover

INSTRUCTIONS

Starting at the neck band

Using shorter 3.5mm circular needle cast on 123 [131, 141, 153, 161, 172, 182, 202] stitches loosely. Join to work in rnd, pm to show rnd start

Rnds 1-3: Knit

Rnd 4: Purl

Rnd 5: Knit

Rnd 6: Purl

Rnds 7-9: Knit

Rnd 10 (set up for incs): k21[23,24,26,28,30,31,35], pm, (k20[21,23,25,26,28,30,33], pm) 4 times, k22[24,25,27,29,30,31,35] to row end marker

Increase for yoke

Rnd 1: (k2, yo, k to 2 sts before marker, yo, k2, sm) to end (12 sts increased)

Rnds 2-4 Knit

Repeat these last 4 rounds a further 8 [11, **12**, 11, 14, 14 15, 17] times so that a total of 9 [12, **13**, 12, 15, 15, 16, 18] increase rows have been worked, changing to longer circular needle when necessary. You will have 231[275, **297**, 297, 341, 352, 374, 418] sts on your needle.

Removing all markers except round end marker, k 13[5, 5, 13, 5, 9, 9, 1] rows even

Starting with a purl row, work 3 rows in g-st

Seperate body and sleeves

K36 [41, 47, 46, 52, 55, 60, 66], move next 44 [55, 55, 55, 66, 66, 66, 77] sts to a stitch holder, using waste yarn provisionally cast on 22 [22, 22, 33, 33, 44, 44, 44] sts, k across these sts, k 71 [83, 93, 95, 105, 110, 122, 132], move next 44 [55, 55, 55, 66, 66, 66, 77] sts to a stitch holder, using waste yarn cast on 22 [22, 22, 33, 33, 44, 44, 44] sts, k across these sts, K36 [41, 47, 46, 52, 55, 60, 66]. You will have 187[209, 231, 253, 275, 308, 330, 352] sts on your needle.

Next Rnd: Knit

Lace rib on body

Rnds 1&2): (K9, p2) to end

Rnd 3: (K1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2tog tbl, k1, p2) to end

Rnd 4: As Rnd 1

Rnd 5: (K2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2tog tbl, k2, p2) to end

Rnd 6: As Rnd 1

Rnd 7: (K3, k2tog, yo, k4, p2) to end

Rnds 8-12: as Rnd 1

Work these 12 rnds a total of 6[6,7,7,7,7,7] times

Starting with a p row, work next 4 rounds in g-st

Cast off using Lace cast off

Sleeves

Using DPNs, unravel provisional cast on at underarm and place these 44 [55, 55, 55, 66, 66, 66, 77] sts onto needle, pick up 22 [22, 22, 33, 33, 44, 44, 44] armhole sts and place on needle. Arrange stitches evenly across DPNs. You will have 66[77, 77, 88, 99, 110, 110, 121] sts on your needles.

Attach yarn at the underarm, pm to show start of rnd.

Knit 2 rnds

Work 12 rows in lace rib patt as follows:

Lace rib pattern

Rnds 1&2: (K9, p2) to end

Rnd 3: (K1, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, k2tog tbl, k1, p2) to end

Rnd 4: As Rnd 1

Rnd 5: (K2, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k2tog tbl, k2, p2) to end

Rnd 6: As Rnd 1

Rnd 7: (K3, k2tog, yo, k4, p2) to end

Rnds 8-12: As Rnd 1

Next rnd (dec): (K9, k2tog) to end. 60[70, 70, 80, 90, 100, 110, 110] sts

Starting with a purl row, work next 4 rnds in g-st

Cast off using lace cast off

FINISHING

Darn in loose ends

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Lace cast off: *(K2 tog tbl, sl worked st back to LH needle) rep from * around.
