MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

192cm (76") wingspan and 35cm (14" depth) at widest point

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Silk Blend Fino (70% Extra Fine Merino / 30% Silk), 450m/490yds per 100g),

1 x 100g hank MC plus 1 Miniskein Set.

Shown in 427 Mourning (MC) with kit 3 Clarissa (436 Porcelain [CC1], 413 Rosewater [CC2], 414 Ivory Letter- opener [CC3], 415 Silver Teaset [CC4], 429 Stormglass [CC5]).

4mm (US 6) 80cm circular needle or longer, or size to obtain gauge

TENSION

17 sts by 34 rows in 10cm square in Garter Stitch

NOTES

- In striped sections, carry yarn not in use loosely up side edge. Do not cut yarn unless instructed to.
- 17 sts and 34 rows = 4" is a blocked gauge. Before blocking, gauge was 20 sts by 40 rows in 10cm square. Because of the silk content, Fino relaxes quite a lot in blocking. If your gauge is too big before blocking, you may run out of yarn.

ABBREVIATIONS

CC: contrast colour

CO: cast on

Inc(d): increase(d)

K: knit

MC: main colour

Ndl: needle

Rep: repeat

RS: right side

Sl: slip

St(s): stitch(es)

Tbl: through back loop

Tog: together

W&t: sl next st purlwise; move yarn to front of work; return slipped st to left ndl; turn the work around so

WS is facing you

WS: wrong side

Yo: yarnover

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, CO 7 sts.

Set-up row (RS): k2, yo, k3, yo, k2. [9 sts]

Rows 1-17: K2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd; 43 sts at end of Row 17]

Row 18: With CC1, k2, yo, k1tbl, k11, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [45 sts]

Row 19: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k3, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd]

Row 20: With CC1, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k3, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd] Rep rows 19 and 20 once more. 53 sts after Row 22. Cut CC1.

Rows 23-32: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd each row; 73 sts after Row 32]

Row 33: With CC2, k2, yo, k1tbl, k20, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [75 sts]

Row 34: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k4, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd]

Row 35: With CC2, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k4, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd] Rep rows 34 and 35 twice more. 87 sts after Row 39. Cut CC2.

Rows 40-55: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd each row; 119 sts after Row 55]

Row 56: With CC3, k2, yo, k1tbl, k36, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [121 sts]

Row 57: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k5, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd]

Row 58: With CC3, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k5, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd] Rep rows 57 and 58 3 times more. 137 sts after Row 64. Cut CC3.

Rows 65-90: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd each row; 189 sts after Row 90]

Row 91: With CC4, k2, yo, k1tbl, k58, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [191 sts]

Row 92: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k6, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd]

Row 93: With CC4, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k6, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd] Rep rows 92 and 93, 4 times more. 211 sts after Row 101. Cut CC4.

Rows 101-136: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd each row; 283 sts after Row 136]

Row 137: With CC5, k2, yo, k1tbl, k91, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [285 sts]

Row 138: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k7, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd]

Row 139: With CC5, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to wrapped st, k next st tog with its wrap, k7, w&t, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd] Rep rows 138 and 139, 7 times more. 317 sts after Row 153. Cut CC5.

Rows 154-166: With MC, k2, yo, k1tbl, k to last 3 sts, k1tbl, yo, k2. [2 sts incd each row; 343 sts after Row 166]

Cast off knitwise, not tightly (outer edge must be relaxed to accommodate curve).

Finishing

Weave in ends. Wet-block to finished measurements.

Note: If you like, you have enough CC yarn left to knit another shawl, reversing the sequence of CCs.
