## SIZE

Circumference: 21" (53cm), one size fits most adults

## MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay Silk Blend (70% superfine merino, 30% silk), approx. 50g/150 yds per 50g,

1 x 50g hank in both MC and CC

Shown in SB2800 Cream (MC) and SB9332 Capricorn (CC)

4.5mm (US 7) 40cm circular needles and double pointed needles or size needed to obtain gauge

3.75mm (US 5) 40cm circular needles

Stitch marker

Waste Yarn

## TENSION

25 sts and 39 rows in a 10cm (4in) square in fairisle pattern with larger needles

## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg:** beginning

**CO:** cast on

**k:** knit

**ndl:** needle

**m1:** miss 1 stitch

**p:** purl

**rnd:** round

**st(s):** stitch(s)

**wyif:** with yarn in front

**wyib:** with yarn in back

**yo:** yarn over

## INSTRUCTIONS

Using waste yarn, smaller ndl, and long-tail cast-on, CO 61 sts. Join, being careful not to twist, and pm to show beg of rnd.

With MC, k1, \*yo, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1. 120 sts. Set-Up rnd 1: \*K1, sl1 wyif; rep from \* to end of rnd. Set-Up rnd 2: \*Sl1 wyib, p1; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rep previous 2 rnds once more. Work in 1 X 1 Rib until band measures 2.5cm (1").

Next rnd: \*K12, m1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 130 sts.

Join CC and work Chart A, repeating rnds 1 – 8 four times (32 rnds total). Work Chart B, changing to dpn when necessary.

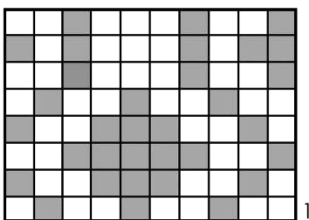
Cut yarn, thread through rem 13 sts, and fasten off.

## FINISHING


Unravel waste yarn. (Don't worry, hat will not fall apart!)

Weave in ends; block.
