tyler 1

SIZE

Bust circumference: 75 (86.5, 96, 106, 116, 127) cm. Sweater shown measures 86.5cm

Length: 65 (66, 67, 70.5, 73, 75) cm.

MATERIALS

- Manos del Uruguay SERENA (60% baby alpaca, 40% pima cotton; approx. 50g, 155m), 8 (9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14) skeins. Shown in S2621 Boysenberry.
- 4mm needles, or size needed to obtain tension
- Cable needles
- Crochet hook

TENSION

• 21 sts and 26 rows 10cm over st st with yarn held double

ABBREVIATION

RDD: Right Double Dec: sl next 2 sts to cn and hold behind LH ndl; ktog next st from LH ndl with 1st st from cn; ktog 2nd st from LH ndl with last st from cn. 2 sts decreased.

LDD: Left Double Dec: sl next 2 sts to cn and hold in front of LH ndl; ktog 1st st from cn with next st from LH ndl; ktog last st from cn with next st from LH ndl. 2 sts decreased.

NOTE

Sweater shown in photo is knit with yarn held double. For a lighter, more drapey garment, yarn may be used singly at the same gauge. Yarn requirements given are for doubled version.

BACK

Cast on 78 (90, 100, 110, 120, 132) sts. Work in st st for 4cm, ending with a WS row. Dec 1 st each end of next row, then every 10 (10, 10, 8, 8, 8)th row 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) times more; 72 (84, 94, 102, 112, 124) sts. Work even until piece measures 20 (21, 21.5, 22, 22, 23) cm, ending with a WS row. Inc 1 st each end of next row then every 10 (10, 10, 8, 8, 8)th row 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 3) times more; 78 (90, 100, 110, 120, 132) sts. Work even until piece measures 40.5 (42, 43, 44.5, 44.5, 45.5) cm ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes:

Cast off 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work 8 (8, 6, 4, 4, 4) rows.

Next row (dec): K1, RDD, k to last 5 sts, LDD, k1.

*Rep this dec row every 8 (8, 6, 4, 4, 4)th rows 5 (2, 7, 3, 6, 9) times more, then every 0 (6, 0, 6, 6, 6) th row 0 (4, 0, 6, 5, 3) times after that.

AT THE SAME TIME, when 42 (42, 42, 42, 46, 52, 52) rows of armhole shaping are complete, shape back neck:

On next RS row, work to center 18 (26, 32, 32, 34, 40) sts, join second ball of yarn, cast off centre 18 (26, 32, 32, 34, 40) sts, work to end. Working both sides at once with separate balls of yarn, cast off from each neck edge 9 sts once, then 4 sts once, then 3 sts once. No sts rem when all decs are complete.

FRONT

Work same as for Back to * . Rep this dec row every 8 (8, 6, 4, 4, 4)th row 4 (1, 4, 3, 6, 9) times more, then every 0 (6, 4, 6, 6, 6)th row 0 (4, 2, 5, 4, 2) times after that.

AT THE SAME TIME, when 28 (28, 26, 36, 40, 40) rows of armhole shaping are complete, shape front neck:

On next RS row, work to centre 6 (14, 20, 20, 22, 28) sts, join second ball of yarn and cast off 6 (14, 20, 20, 22, 28) sts, work to end. Working both sides at once with separate balls of yarn, cast off from each neck edge 8 sts once, then 7 sts once, then 4 sts once, then 2 sts twice, then 1 st once. No sts rem when all decs are complete.

LEFT SLEEVE

Cast off 84 (86, 86, 86, 90, 90) sts. Work in st st and inc 1 st each end every 3 (4, 4, 3, 4, 4) rows a total of 5 (4, 4, 6, 6, 6) times; 94 (94, 94, 98, 102, 102) sts. Work even until piece measures 7.5 (7.5, 7.5, 9, 10, 10)cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap: Cast off 2 (2, 2, 3, 3, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Work 6 rows even. Next row (dec): K1, RDD, k to last 5 sts, LDD, k1. Rep this dec row every 6th row 6 (6, 6, 4, 5, 1) time more, then every 0 (0, 0, 8, 8, 8)th row 0 (0, 0, 2, 2, 5) times. **Work 2 rows even. 62 (62, 62, 64, 64, 66) sts.

Next row (WS): Cast off 20 (20, 20, 21, 21, 22) sts, p to end. Next row: K

Next row: Slipping first st, cast off 20 (20, 20, 21, 21, 21) sts, p to end. Next row: K1, RDD, k to end.

Next row: Slipping first st, cast off rem 20 (20, 20, 20, 20, 21) sts.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Work as for Left Sleeve to **. Work 3 rows straight.

Next row (RS): Cast off 20 (20, 20, 21, 21, 22) sts, k to end. Next

Next row: Slipping first st, cast off 20 (20, 20, 21, 21, 21) sts, k to last 5 sts, LDD, k1. Next row: P.

Next row: Slipping first st, cast off rem 20 (20, 20, 20, 20, 21) sts.

FINISHING

Block pieces lightly to size. Sew raglan seams. Pin 6 pleats in place at top of each sleeve, folding pleats towards centre of sleeve on WS (see schematic for pleat placement). Top of sleeve should measure 11.5 (11.5, 11.5, 12, 12, 12.5)cm with pleats in place. Work 1 rnd of double crochet around neck edge, working through all thicknesses to hold pleats in place. Work another rnd of double crochet; fasten off. Sew side and sleeve seams. Work 1 row double crochet around bottom and sleeve edges. Weave in ends.
