MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

Length 143cm (56in); width (excluding points) 40cm (16in); width including points 44cm (17¼in).

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Alegria (75% Superwash Merino / 25% Polyamide), 425m/445yds per 100g),

1 x 100g hank

Shown in #8106 Botanico

4mm (US #6) needles

TENSION

16 sts x 43.5 rows in a 10cm (4in) square over pattern using 4mm needles. Exact tension is not essential but it may affect the amount of yarn used.

ABBREVIATIONS:

K: Knit

P: Purl

K2tog: Knit 2 stitches together

RS: Right side

YO: Yarn over. Note that you will work your YO in a different way, depending on the stitch worked before the YO and the stitch you will work after the YO, as follows:

YFWD: Yarn forward as follows: YFWD is a YO between two knit stitches. After your knit stitch your yarn is behind the needles. Bring the yarn forward between the needles and then knit the next stitch

YRN: Yarn round needle as follows: YRN is a YO between two purl stitches. Purl one stitch and you'll find your yarn is in front; bring the yarn all the way around the needle until it is back in front again and then purl your next stitch

YON: Yarn over needle as follows: YON is a YO after a purl and before a knit stitch. Purl one stitch and your yarn will be in front; take it around (over) the needle to the back so it is behind the needle and then knit the next stitch

YFRN: Yarn forward round needle as follows: YFRN is a YO after a knit and before a purl stitch. After you knit your stitch, the yarn will be behind your needles. Bring the yarn forward between the needles and then all the way around the needle until it is in front again before purling the next stitch

Tog: Together.

Ssk: Slip the first stitch on the LH needle (as if to knit) to the RH needle without actually knitting it. Do the same with the next stitch. Insert the LH needle into the front loops of these two stitches (from left to right) and knit the 2 stitches together (to decrease 1 st).

Sl1pyf: Slip 1 st purlwise with yarn in front.

Sl1: Slip 1.

Sk2po: Slip 1 stitch, knit next 2 sts together, pass slipped stitch over (to decrease 2 sts).

RCO: Russian Cast off as follows: k2, *slip both sts back to left hand needle, k2togtbl, k1; repeat from * until correct number of sts have been cast off.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 65 sts, using a stretchy cast on method.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2-4: Sl1, knit to end.

Start 24-row pattern:

Row 1 (RS): Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, *p4, k2, yo, k2, ssk, p3, yo, k2, ssk, p7, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once more, k3. (66 sts).

Row 2 (WS): Sl1pyf, k2, *p4, k7, p4, k3, p6, k4; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k5. (66 sts).

Row 3: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, *p4, k3, yo, k2, ssk, p3, yo, k2, ssk, p5, k2tog, k2, yo, p1; repeat from * once more, k3. (67 sts).

Row 4: Sl1pyf, k2, *k1, p4, k5, p4, k3, p7, k4; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k6. (67 sts).

Row 5: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, *p3, k2tog, k2, yo, p1, [yo, k2, ssk, p3] twice, k2tog, k2, yo, p2; repeat from * once more, k3. (68 sts).

Row 6: Sl1pyf, k2, *k2, [p4, k3] twice, p4, k1, p4, k3; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k7. (68 sts).

Row 7: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, *p2, k2tog, k2, yo [p3, yo k2, ssk] twice, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, p3; repeat from * once more, k3. (69 sts)

Row 8: Sl1pyf, k2, *k3, p4, k1, [p4, k3] twice, p4, k2; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k8. (69 sts).

Row 9: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, *p1, k2tog, k2, yo, p5, yo, k2, ssk, p3, yo, k2, skpo, k2, yo, p4; repeat from * once more, k3. (70 sts).

Row 10: Sl1pyf, k2, *k4, p7, k3, p4, k5, p4, k1; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k9. (70 sts).

Row 11: [RCO] 5 times, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, *k2tog, k2, yo, p7, yo, k2, ssk, p3, yo, k2, sk2po, yo, p5; repeat from * once more, k3. (65 sts).

Row 12: Sl1pyf, k2, *k5, p5, k3, p4, k7, p4; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k4. (65 sts).

Row 13: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, *yo, k2, ssk, p7, k2tog, k2, yo, p4, yo, k2, ssk, p5; repeat from * once more, k3. (66 sts).

Row 14: Sl1pyf, k2, *k5, p4, k4, p4, k7, p4; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k5. (66 sts).

Row 15: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, *p1, yo, k2, ssk, p5, k2tog, k2, yo, p3, k3, yo, k2, ssk, p4; repeat from * once more, k3. (67 sts).

Row 16: Sl1pyf, k2, *k4, p7, k3, p4, k5, p4, k1; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo k6. (67 sts).

Row 17: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k3, k2tog, yo, k1, *p2, yo, k2, ssk, [p3, k2tog, k2, yo] twice, p1, yo, k2, ssk, p3; repeat from * once more, k3. (68 sts).

Row 18: Sl1pyf, k2, *k3, p4, k1, [p4, k3] twice, p4, k2; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k7. (68 sts).

Row 19: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k2tog, [yo] twice, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, *p3, yo, k2, ssk, p1, [k2tog, k2, yo, p3] twice, yo, k2, ssk, p2; repeat from * once more, k3. (69 sts).

Row 20: Sl1pyf, k2, *k2, [p4, k3] twice, p4, k1, p4, k3; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k8. (69 sts).

Row 21: Sl1pyf, k1, yo, k5, k2tog, yo, k1, *p4, yo, k2, sk2po, k2, yo, p3, k2tog, k2, yo, p5, yo, k2, ssk, p1; repeat from * once more, k3. (70 sts).

Row 22: Sl1pyf, k2, *k1, p4, k5, p4, k3, p7, k4; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k9. (70 sts)

Row 23: [RCO] 5 times, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, *p5, yo, k2, sk2po, yo, p3, k2tog, k2, yo, p7, yo, k2, ssk; repeat from * once more, k3. (65 sts).

Row 24: Sl1pyf, k2, *p4, k7, p4, k3, p5, k5; repeat from * once more, k2tog, yo, k4. (65 sts).

Rows 1-24 set the pattern. Repeat Rows 1 -24, another 12 times or to the desired length, leaving enough yarn for the five end rows.

Next 4 rows: Sl1, knit to end.

Cast off using Russian Cast off.

Block shawl to measurements.
