



Destello Scarf

SIZES

5½" x 68"

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay ALPACA HEATHER (70% wool, 30% alpaca; approx. 100g / 328 yds OR 50g / 164 yds): 1 sk each of MC (100g), CC1 (50g), CC2 (50g), and CC3 (50g)

Shown in H704 Beige (MC), H2150 Bing Cherry (CC1), H2121 Cinnamon (CC2), and H2110 Zinnia (CC3)

US6 / 4mm ndl, or size to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

GAUGE

22 sts = 4" over Garter Stitch

NOTES

This scarf uses short rows worked without wraps. To close the gap between the turn and the next stitch of the row, do as follows: when you reach the gap, insert the tip of the left needle into the bump on the side of the stitch before the gap (the one on the right needle). Then knit together this picked-up strand with the next stitch on the left needle.

When working striped sections, do not cut yarn unless told to do so. Instead, carry it loosely up the side of the work until needed again.

ABBREVIATIONS

CC: contrast color

k: knit

MC: main color

rep: repeat

st(s): stitch(es)

INSTRUCTIONS

With MC, cast on 30 sts. Knit 4 rows. Now join CC1 and work in Stripe Sequence as follows:

Stripe Sequence:

*Stripe 1: With CC, k7, turn, k to end of row.

Stripe 2: With MC, knit 2 rows, closing short-row gap when you come to it (see Notes).

Stripe 3: With CC, k14, turn, k to end of row.

Stripe 4: With MC, knit 2 rows, closing short-row gap when you come to it.

Stripe 5: With CC, k21, turn, k to end of row.

Stripe 6: With MC, knit 2 rows, closing short-row gap when you come to it.

Stripe 7: With CC, k14, turn, k to end of row.

Stripe 8: With MC, knit 2 rows, closing short-row gap when you come to it.

Rep Stripe Sequence three more times, then rep Stripe 1 once more. Cut CC1.

Knit 1 row MC.

Join CC2 and work Stripe Sequence four times, then work Stripe 1 once more. Cut CC2.

Knit 1 row MC.

Join CC3 and work Stripe Sequence four times, then rep Stripe 1 once more. Cut CC3.

Knit 1 row MC.*

Rep from * to * until you have 12 total sections, with 4 sections of each CC.

Knit 3 rows MC. Bind off knitwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Steam-block.
