## Materials

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*Manos del Uruguay, Alegría Grande*

180 m (197 yds) per 100 grs skein  
75% wool, 25% nylon  
2 skeins

## Finished Measurement

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*One Size*

27, 5" x 63" / 70 x 160 cm



## Needles and Tools

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- Size US #7 / 4,5mm needle

NOTIONS

tapestry needle

## Gauge

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18 sts x 20 rows in stockinette stitch  
after blocking

*Gauge is not crucial for this project. However, changes might result in a different yardage requirement.*

## Abbreviations

**CO** cast on

**k** knit

**p** purl

**RS** right side

**WS** wrong side

**kfb** increase, knit 1 stitch through the front leg, leave it in the left needle, then knit it through the back leg.

yo wrap the working yarn over the right needle, from front to back (counter-clockwise)

**SLwyif** slip stitch purlwise, with the yarn in the front

**SLwyib** slip stitch knitwise, with the yarn in the back.  
sts stitches

[ ] repeat all stitches inside, \* times

## Techniques

Cast on, knit and purl stitches, yarn over,  
Increasing and decreasing, bind off.

## About the pattern

This shawl is an asymmetrical triangle. It will start with a few stitches on the right tip, and then make the increases to create a triangular shape until you reach the top edge.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

### Section 1.

CO 5 sts

**Row 1** (RS) - k2, SL3wyif

**Row 2** (WS) - k3, kfb, k1 (6sts)

**Row 3** (RS) - k3, SL3wyif (6)

**Row 4** (WS) - k3, p1, kfb, k1 (7sts)

**Row 5** (RS) - k4, SL3wyif

**Row 6** (WS) - k3, purl all sts to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (8sts)

**Row 7** (RS) - Knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 8** (WS) - k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 (9sts)

Repeat row 7 and 8 until you have 44 sts (36 times more)



## Section 2. Textured stitches

**Row 1** (RS) - knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 2** (WS) - k3, p2, [k1, SL1wyib] to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1

**Row 3** (RS) - repeat row 1

**Row 4** (WS) - k3, p2, [SL1wyib, k1], to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Rows 5 to 20:** Repeat rows 1 to 4 for four times more

**Rows 21 to 39** (RS): Knit to last 4sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Rows 22 to 40** (WS): k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Rows 41 to 60,** repeat rows 1 to 20

**Rows 61 to 80,** repeat rows 21 to 40

Finally, you have 84 sts on your needles.

## Section 3- Lace stitches

**Row 1** (RS) - knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 2** (WS) - k3, p2, [k1, SL1wyib] to last 3 sts, k1, kfb, k1

**Row 3** (RS) - repeat row 1

**Row 4** (WS) - k3, p2, [SL1wyib, k1] to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 5** (RS) - Knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 6** (WS) - k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1  
Work rows 1 to 16 of the Chart 1, for four times, then repeat rows 1 to 8 once time again.

## Chart 1. Written instructions

**Row 1** (RS): k3, [yo, ssk, k4, yo, ssk] to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 2** and even rows (WS): k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 3** (RS): k4, [k1, yo, ssk, k3, yo, ssk]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 5** (RS): k5, [k2, yo, ssk, k2, yo, ssk]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 7**(RS): k6, [k3, yo, ssk, k1, yo, ssk]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 9** (RS): k4, k2tog, yo, k1, [k3, k2tog,yo, k2tog, yo, k1]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

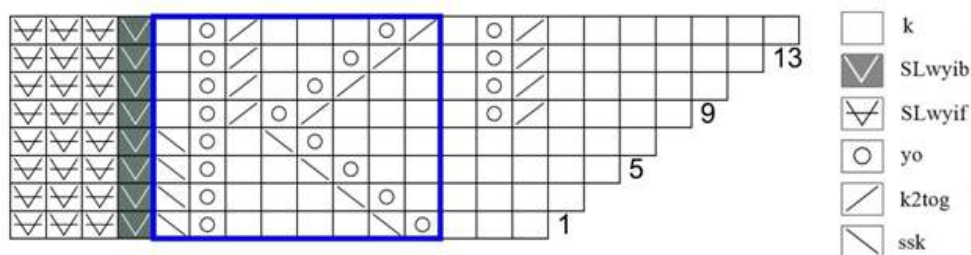
**Row 11**(RS): k5, k2tog, yo, k1, [k2, k2tog,yo, k1,k2tog, yo, k1]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 13**(RS): k6, k2tog, yo, k1, [k1, k2tog,yo,k2,k2tog, yo, k1]to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 15**(RS): k7, k2tog, yo, k1, [k2tog,yo, k3,k2tog, yo, k1] to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Chart 1.** Work rows 1 to 16 four times, then rows 1 to 8 once time again.

**Row 2 and even rows** (WS): k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1





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### Finishing

**Row 1 (RS)** - Knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 2 (WS)** - k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Row 3 (RS)** - knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 4 (WS)** - k3, p2, [k1, SL1wyib] to last 3sts, k1, kfb, k1

**Row 5 (RS)** - repeat row 1

**Row 6 (WS)** - k3, p2, [SL1wyib, k1] to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

**Rows 7 to 10:** Repeat row 3 to 6 once time more

**Row 11 (RS)** - Knit to last 4 sts, SL1wyib, SL3wyif

**Row 12 (WS)** - k3, purl to last 2 sts, kfb, k1

Bind off loosely all stitches

**Classic bind off**, knit one stitch, slip to left needles and pass the stitch over the last stitch you knit and over the top of the right needle.

Weave in loose ends and block to finished measurements your shawl.





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
