Salvador Sweater

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You will fall in love with the Salvador sweater for its playful geometric motif and its striking color combo. It is knitted flat in intarsia, front, back and sleeves separately. The fit is oversized and boxy, with a dropped sleeve.

Finished Measurements

Sizes - (1) 2 (3)

Bust circumference - (47) 55 (63)" / (120) 140 (160) cms.

Yarn and Quantities

Cardo, Manos del Uruguay. (100% corriedale), approx. 109 yds / 100 mts per 100 g.

Quantities:

Color A: Pumpkin, (2) 2 (5)

Color B: Cirrus (2) 2 (3)

Color C: Very Vivid (2) 2 (4)

Color D: Nymph (2) 2 (3)

Color D: Spirulina (2) 2 (3)

Needles and Tools

- One pair of straight needles in size 8,0 mm / #11 US. (Or size to obtain gauge)
- One pair of straight needles in size 6,0 mm / #10 US. (Or size to obtain gauge)
- Circular knitting 6,0 mm / #10 US (to knit ribs)
- 1 tapestry needle.

Gauge

12.5 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] with 8,0 mm / #11 US, in stockinette stitch (intarsia), after blocking.

Abbreviations

- K**- Knit. **P**- Purl.
RS- Right Side. **WS**- Wrong Side.
St/Sts- Stitch/Stitches.
k2tog - Knit 2 stitches together
B.O.: Bind off

Increases Abbreviations

M1R: Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from back to front, then knit this strand.

M1L: Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from front to back, then knit this strand through the back loop (twisted).

Instructions

This sweater will be worked back and forth, knitting the front, back and sleeves separately, sewing all the pieces and finally knitting the neck rib.

Front, back, and sleeves are worked in intarsia in stockinette stitch, following the different charts.

BACK

With A color (Pumpkin), using 6,0 mm / #10 US needles, cast on (87) 99 (111) sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to 1 st. before the end, k1.

Row 2: (p1, k1) to 1 st. before the end, p1.

Work these 2 rows until piece measures 2" (5,0 cms) from the cast on edge.

Change to 8,0 mm / #11 US needles.

For size 1 only:

Set up row (RS): (K7, k2tog) to las 6 sts. before the end, k3, k2tog, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased)

For size 2 only:

Set up row (RS): (K8, k2tog) to last 9 sts. before the end, K6, k2tog, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased).

For size 3 only:

Set up row (RS): (K9, k2tog) to last 1 st. before the end, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased).

Now you have (77) 89 (101) sts. on the needles.

Work a WS row for all sizes as if this were the row 2 of your intarsia chart.

From here we start to work (in stockinette stitch) the intarsia chart for each size until you have knitted a total of (86) 96 (106) rows. (not including the rib rows).

Neck and Shoulders

Row 1 (RS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts, k (19) 22 (25), B.O. (23) 27 (31) sts., knit to the end of the row.

Keep the stitches from the right shoulder on holding and continue working only on the **LEFT SHOULDER** stitches as follow:

Row 2 (WS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., purl to the end of the row.

Row 3 (RS): B.O. (3) 4 (5) sts, knit to the end of the row.

Row 4 (WS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., purl to the end of the row.

Now you have (8) 9 (10) sts. on your needles

Bind off and cut yarn.

Place **RIGHT SHOULDER** stitches back on the

FRONT

With A color (Pumpkin), using 6,0 mm / #10 US needles, cast on (87) 99 (111) sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to 1 st. before the end, k1.

Row 2: (p1, k1) to 1 st. before the end, p1.

Work these 2 rows until piece measures 2" (5,0 cms) from the cast on edge.

Change to 8,0 mm / #11 US needles

For size 1 only:

Set up row (RS): (K7, k2tog) to last 6 sts. before the end, k3, k2tog, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased)

For size 2 only:

Set up row (RS): (K8, k2tog) to last 9 sts. before the end, K6, k2tog, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased).

For size 3 only:

Set up row (RS): (K9, k2tog) to last 1 st. before the end, k1. (10 sts. have been decreased).

Now you have (77) 89 (101) sts. on the needles.

Work a WS row for all sizes as if this were the row 2 of your intarsia chart.

From here we start to work (in stockinette stitch) the intarsia chart for each size until you have knitted a total of (73) 80 (90) rows. (Not including the rib rows).

Neck and Shoulders

Row 1 (RS): K (35) 39 (43), B.O. (7) 11 (15) sts., knit to the end of the row.

Keep the stitches from the left shoulder on holding and continue working only on the **RIGHT SHOULDER** stitches as follow:

Row 2 (WS): Purl.

Row 3 (RS): B.O. (4) 5 (6) sts., knit to the end of the row.

Row 4 (WS): Purl.

Row 5 (RS): B.O. 3 sts., knit to the end of the row.

Row 6 (WS): Purl.

Row 7 (RS): B.O. 2 sts., knit to the end of the row.

Row 8 (WS): Purl.

Row 9 (RS): B.O. 1 st., knit to the end of the row.

Row 10 (WS): Purl.

Repeat these last 2 rows one more time.

Row 13 (RS): Knit.

Row 14 (WS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., purl to the end of the row.

Row 15 (RS): Knit.

Row 16 (WS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., purl to the end of the row.

Now you have (8) 9 (10) sts. on your needles

Bind off and cut yarn.

Place **LEFT SHOULDER** stitches back on the needle, continue working on the WS as follow:

Row 1 (WS): BO (4) 5 (6) sts, purl to the end of the row.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Row 3 (WS): BO 3 sts, purl to the end of the row.

Row 4 (RS): Knit.

Row 5 (WS): BO 2 sts, purl to the end of the row.

Row 6 (RS): Knit.

Row 7 (WS): BO 1 st, purl to the end of the row.

Row 8 (RS): Knit.

Repeat these last 2 rows one more time.

Row 11 (WS): Purl.

Row 12 (RS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., knit to the end of the row.

Row 13 (WS): Purl.

Row 14 (RS): B.O. (8) 9 (10) sts., knit to the end of the row.

Row 15 (WS): Purl.

Now you have (8) 9 (10) sts. on your needles.

Size 1

Bind off and cut yarn.

Size 2 and 3

Work in stockinette stitch for 3 more rows.

Bind off and cut yarn.

SLEEVES

The sleeve shape is the same for both left and right, but you will have to follow different color charts for each.

With A color (Pumpkin), using 6,0 mm / #10 US needles, cast on (33) 39 (45) sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to 1 st. before the end, k1.

Row 2: (p1, k1) to 1 st. before the end, p1.

Work these 2 rows until piece measures 2" (5,0 cms) from the cast on edge.

Change to 8,0 mm / #11 US needles.

From here we start to work the sleeve shape (in stockinette stitch/intarsia chart) by making increases.

Make **4 increases**, evenly spaced, in the first

row of the Stockinette Stitch.

Now you have (37) 43 (49) sts. on the needles.

We will continue knitting in St st until the sleeve measures (17) 17.5 (19)" (43) 45 (47) cms from the cast on edge. At the same time we will make a total of (8) 9 (9) increases rows every 6 St st rows.

Increase Row (RS): K1, M1L, knit to last 1 st. until the end, M1R, k1.

Now you have (53) 61 (67) sts. on your needles.

Bind off and cut yarn.

Step by step to join the pieces

1- Join the shoulders of the front with those of the back by a crochet chain.

2- With the sleeves still open, join them to the front and back. Be careful that the sleeves are centered with respect to the shoulder centre line.

3- Join the sides of the sleeve using Mattress Stitch technique.

IMPORTANT: We will make the sew half stitch from the edge.

4- Join the sides of the front with the back using using Mattress Stitch technique.

Neckline Rib

After joining all the pieces we are going to pick up, with the circular needle, an even number of stitches, on the neckline, as follows:

Using 6,0 mm / #10 US needles, with the RS towards us:

Pick up 2 stitches every 3 stitches.

After picking up all stitches, work 1x1 rib (k1, p1) for 6 rows.

End with a tubular bind off for 1x1 rib.

IMPORTANT: This ratio of stitches in the pick up depends on the gauge with which we are working, therefore it can vary for each particular case. If required, it is recommended to do the calculation for each specific case.

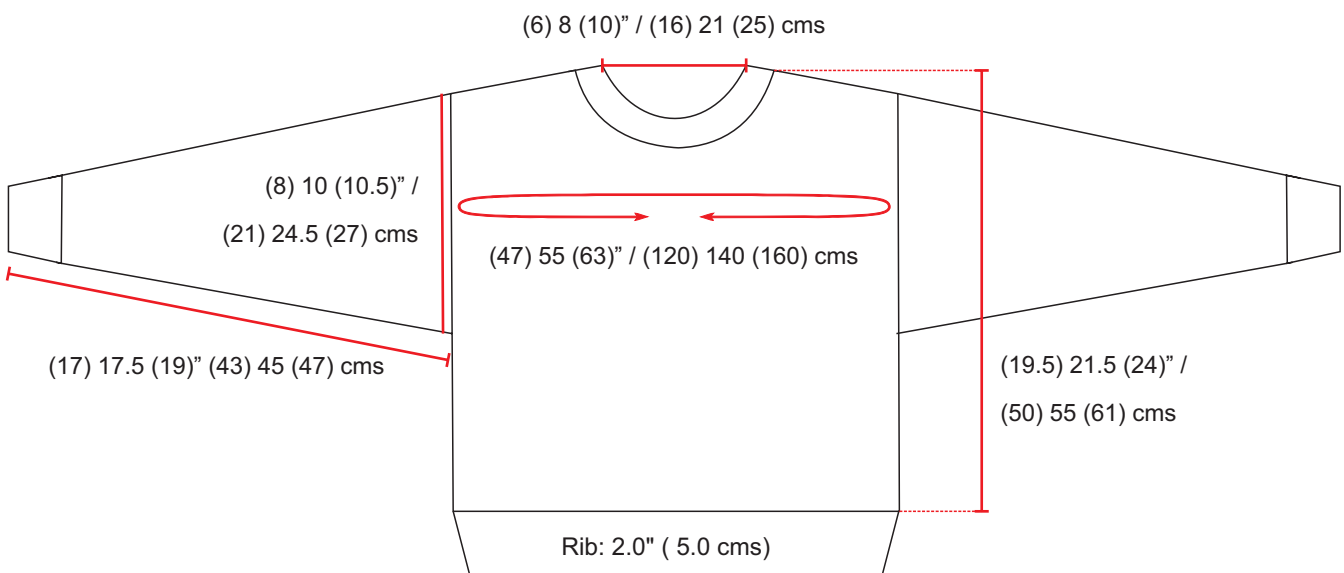

FINISHING

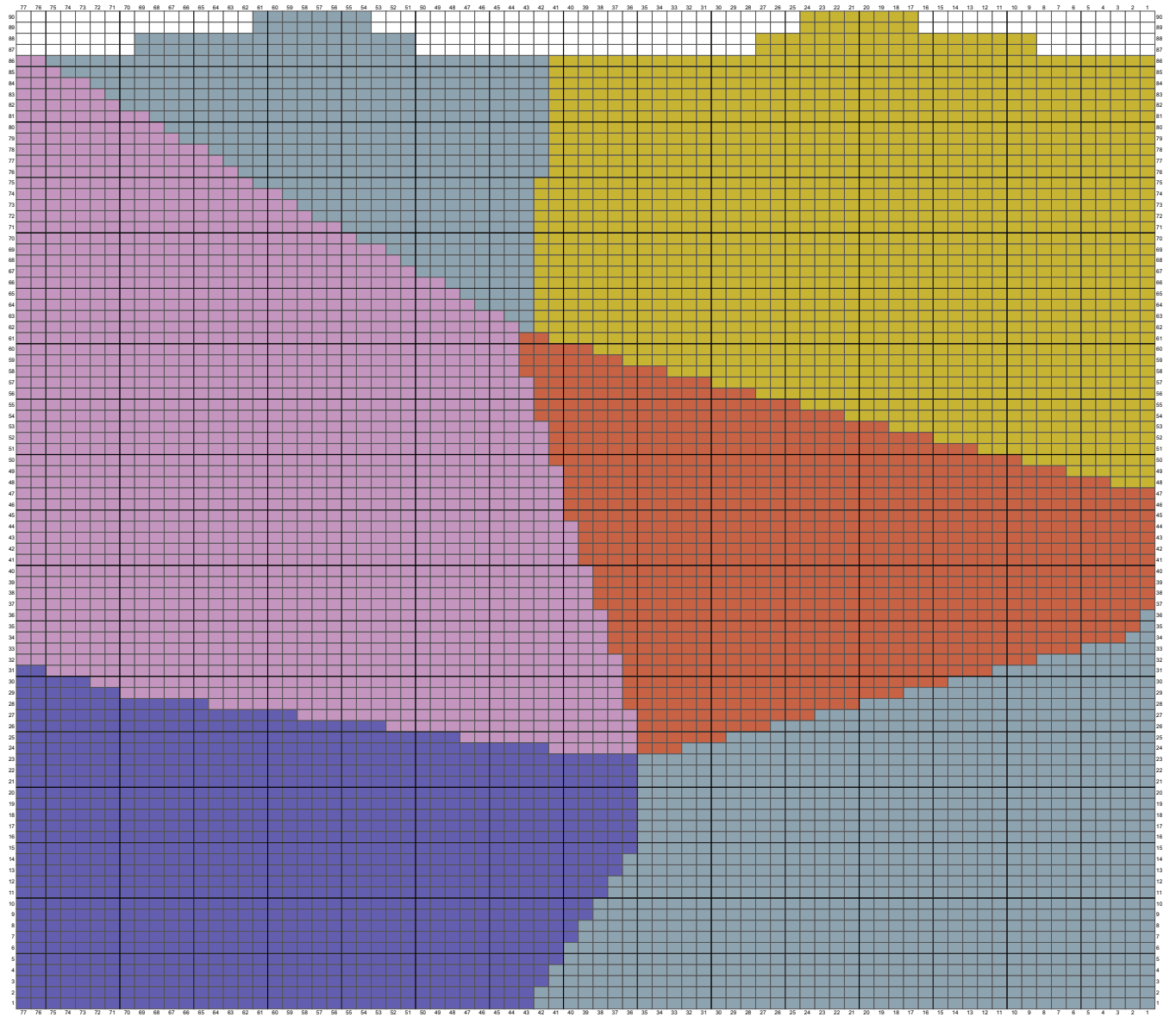
Weave in ends. Steam- or wet-block piece to finished measurements.

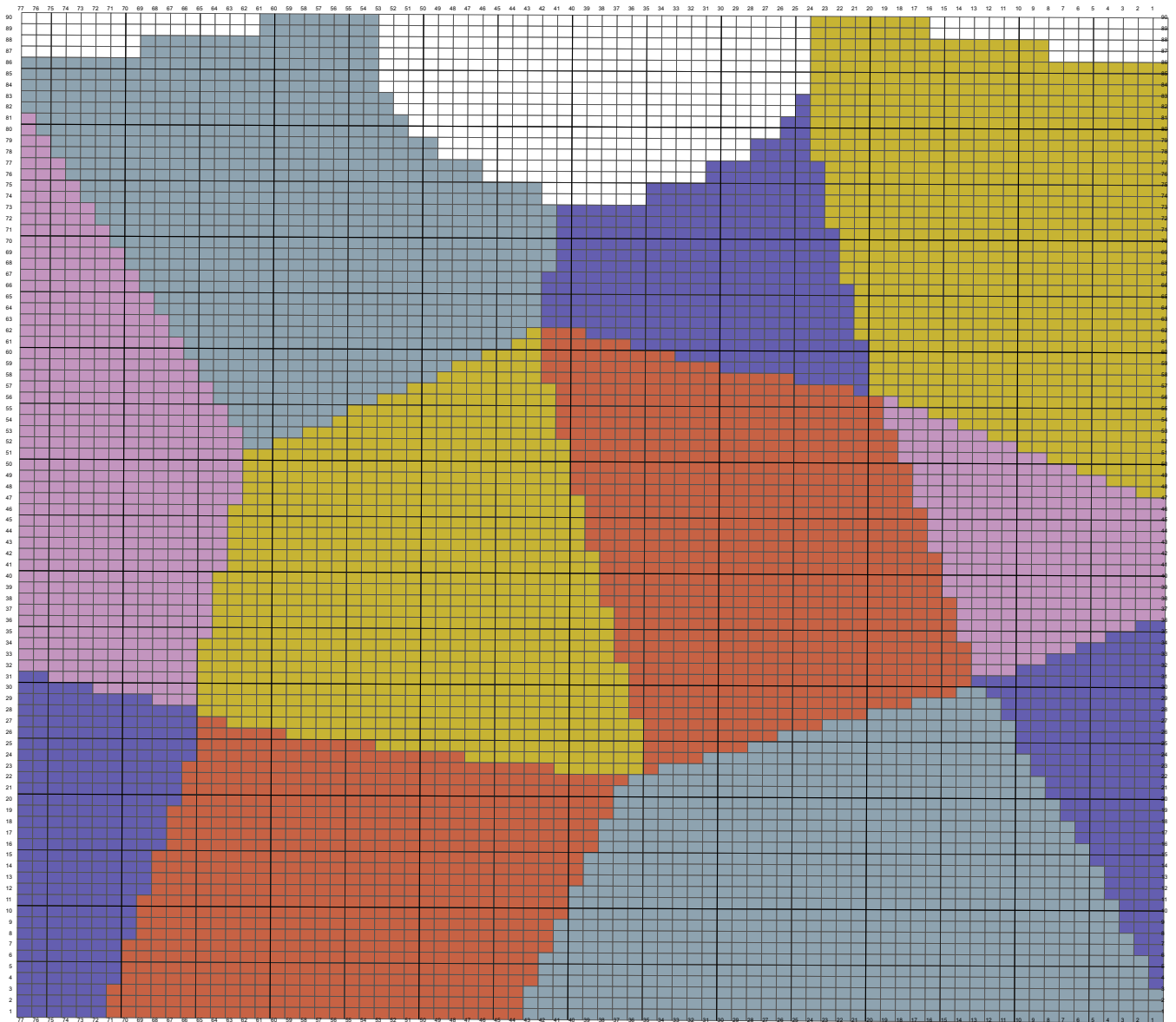

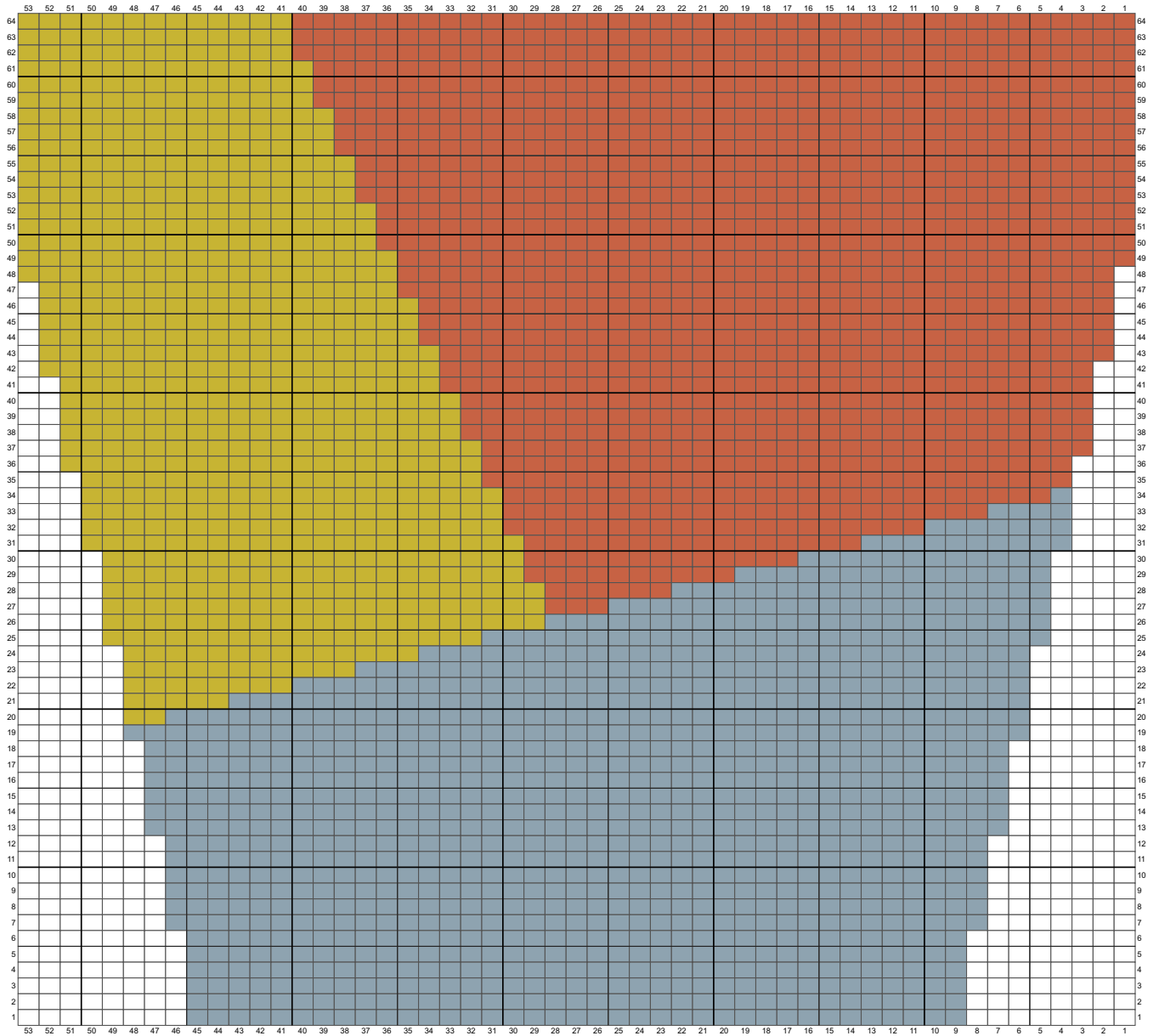
Size 1 - Front

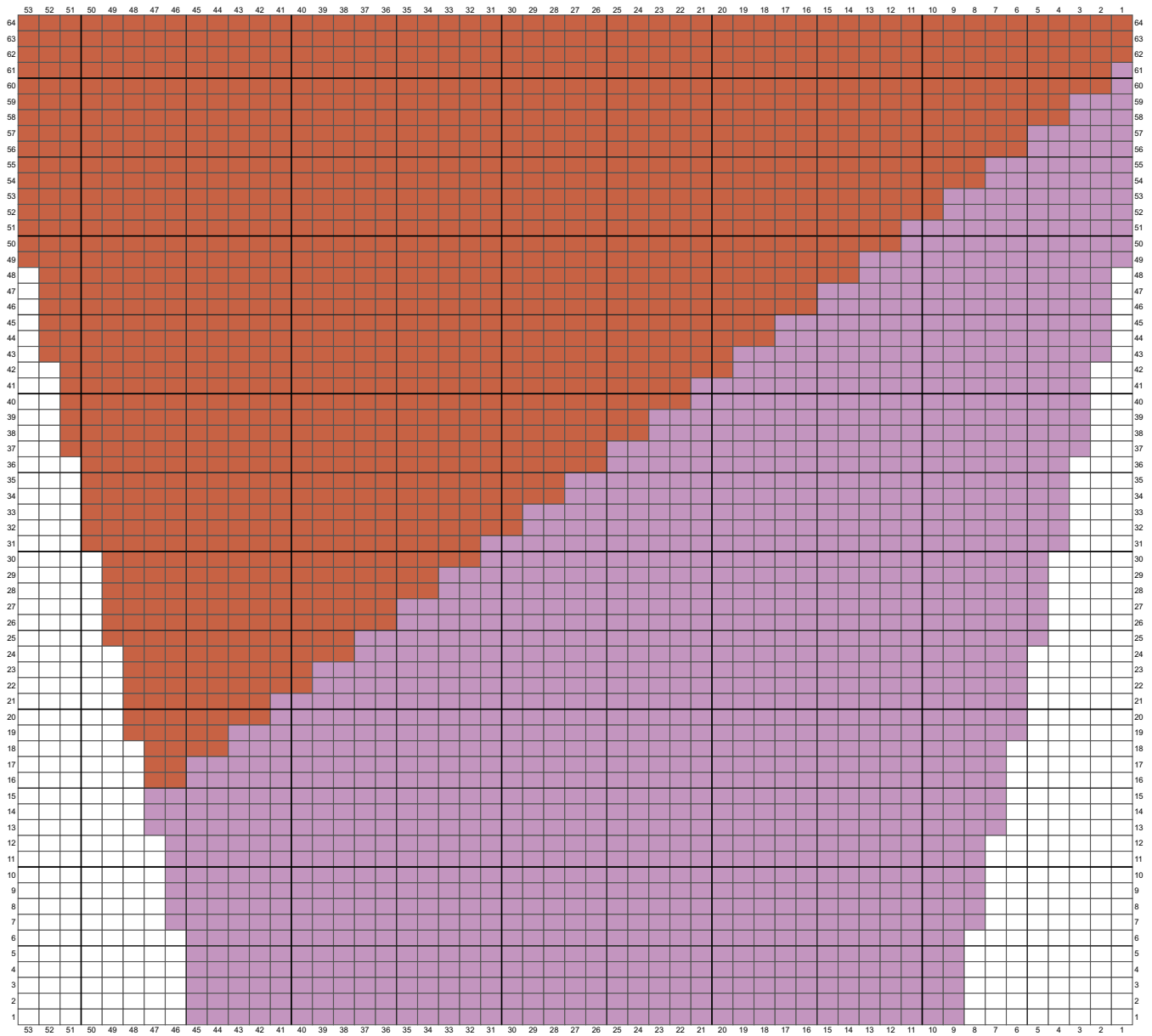

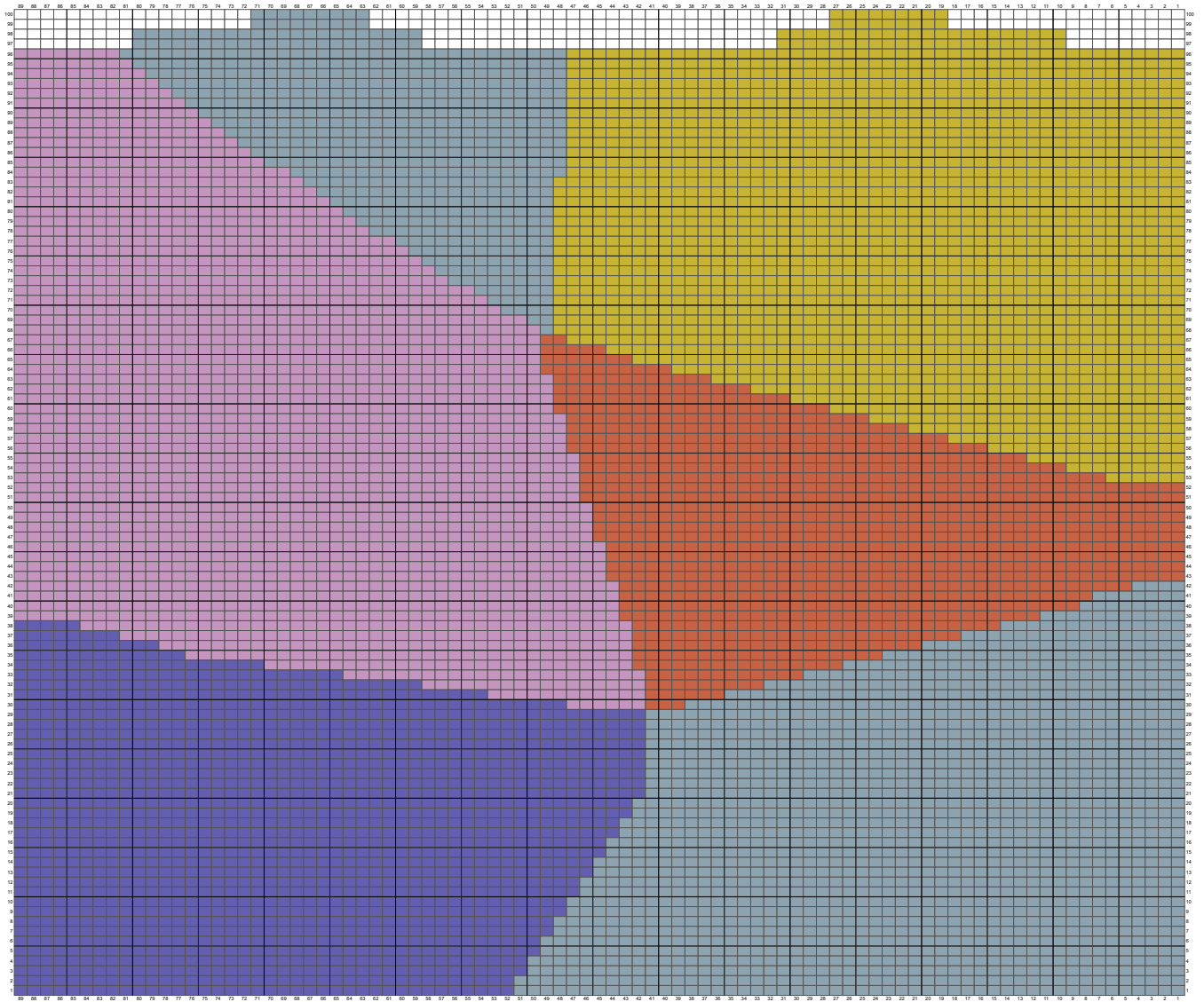

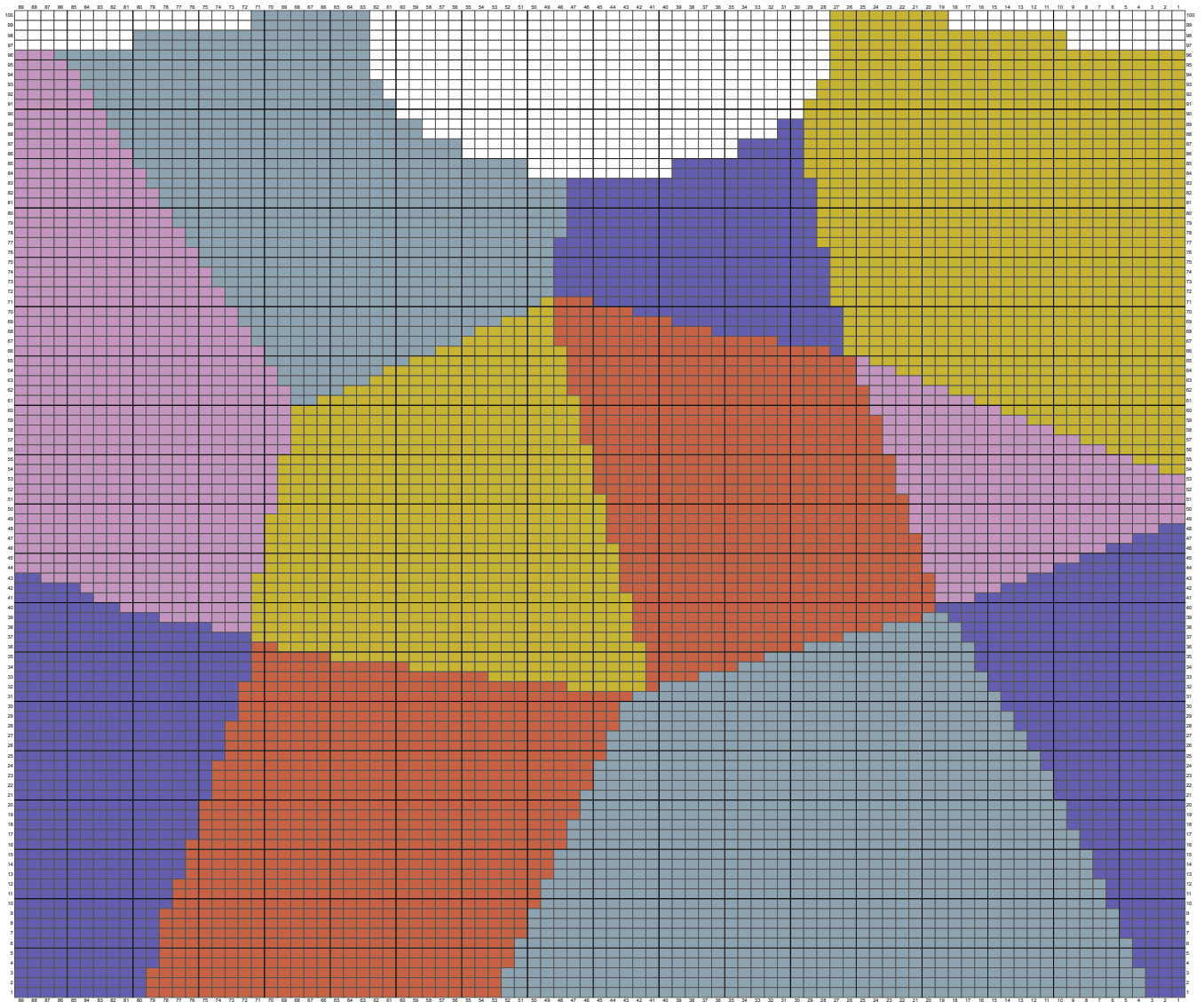

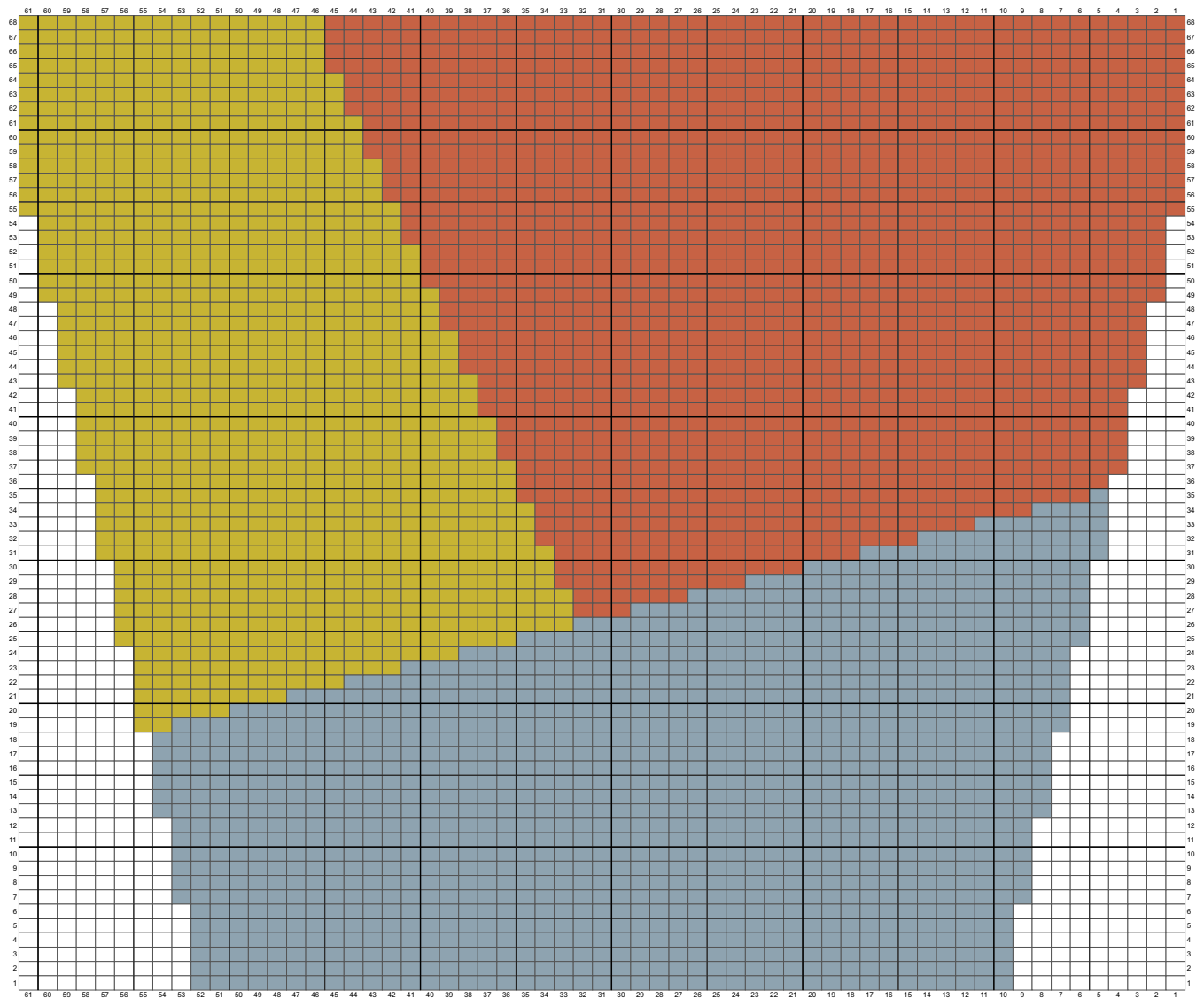

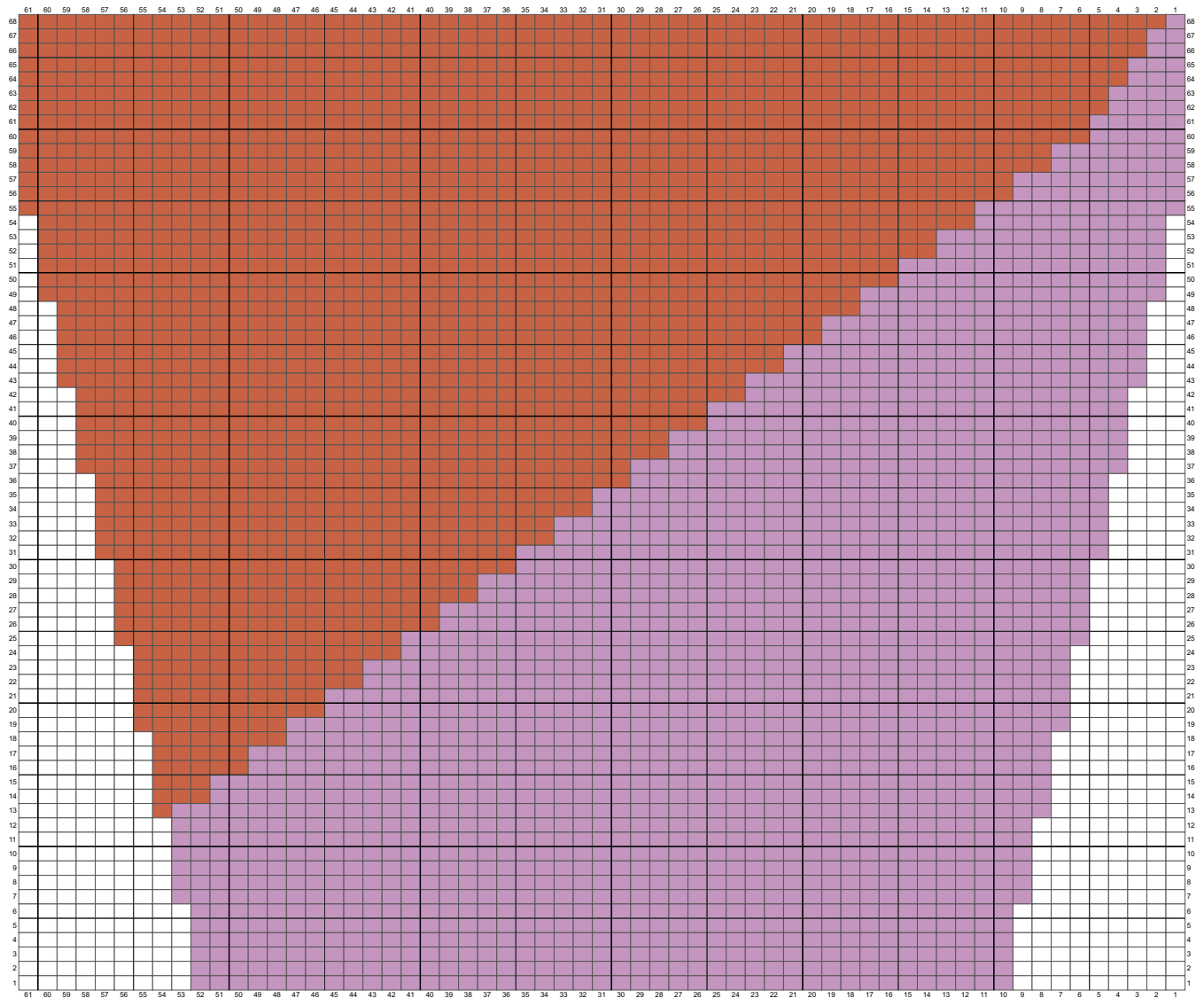

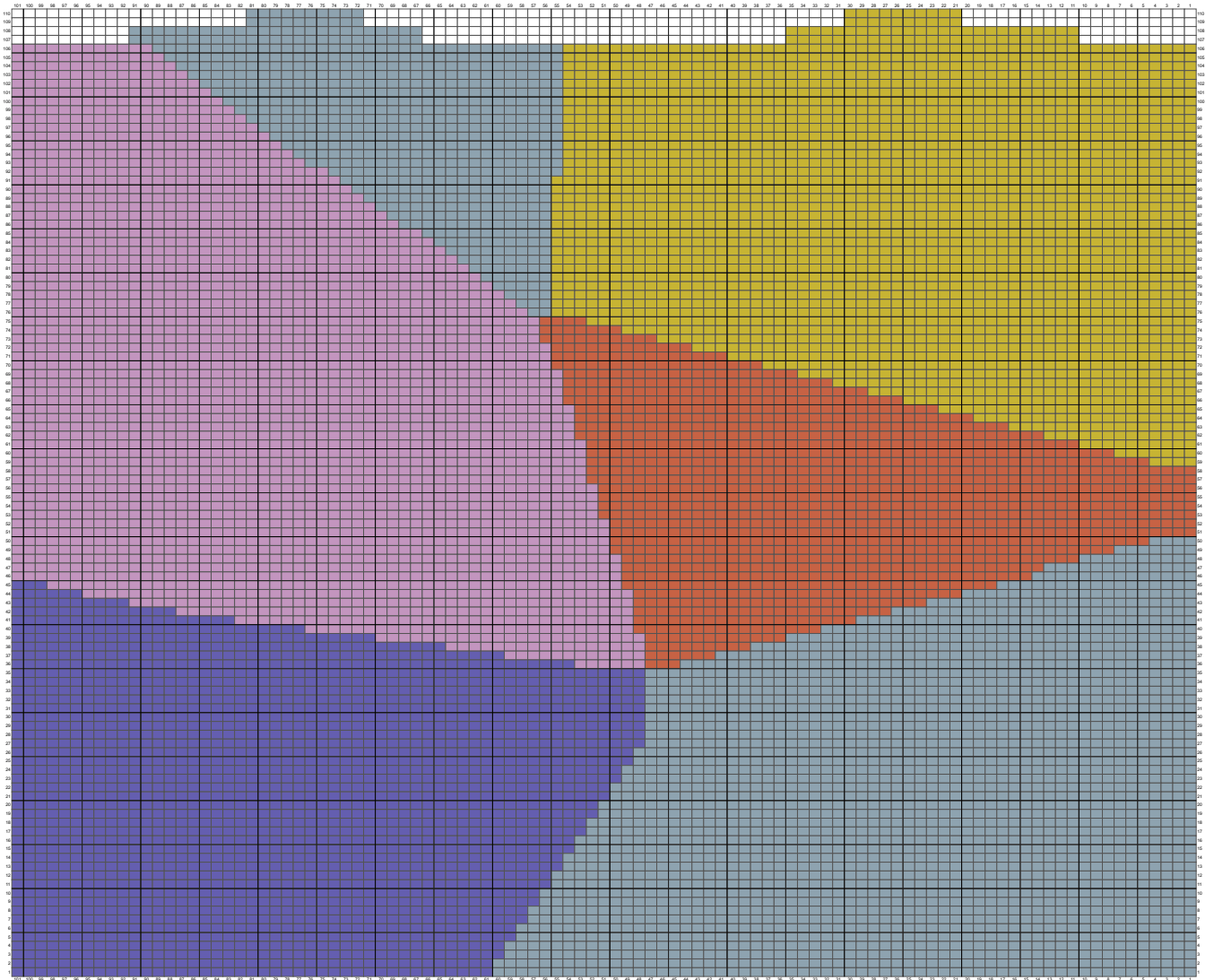

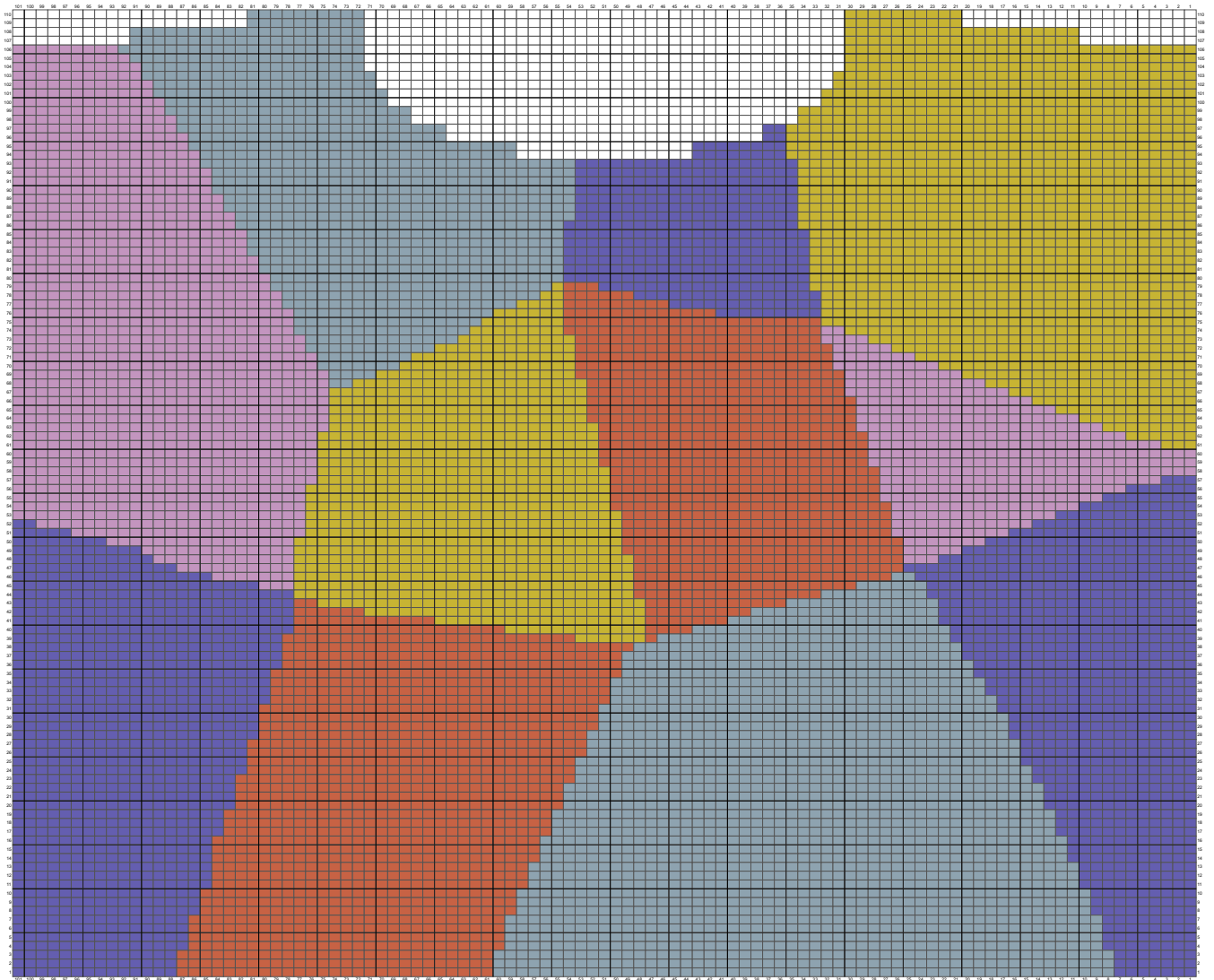

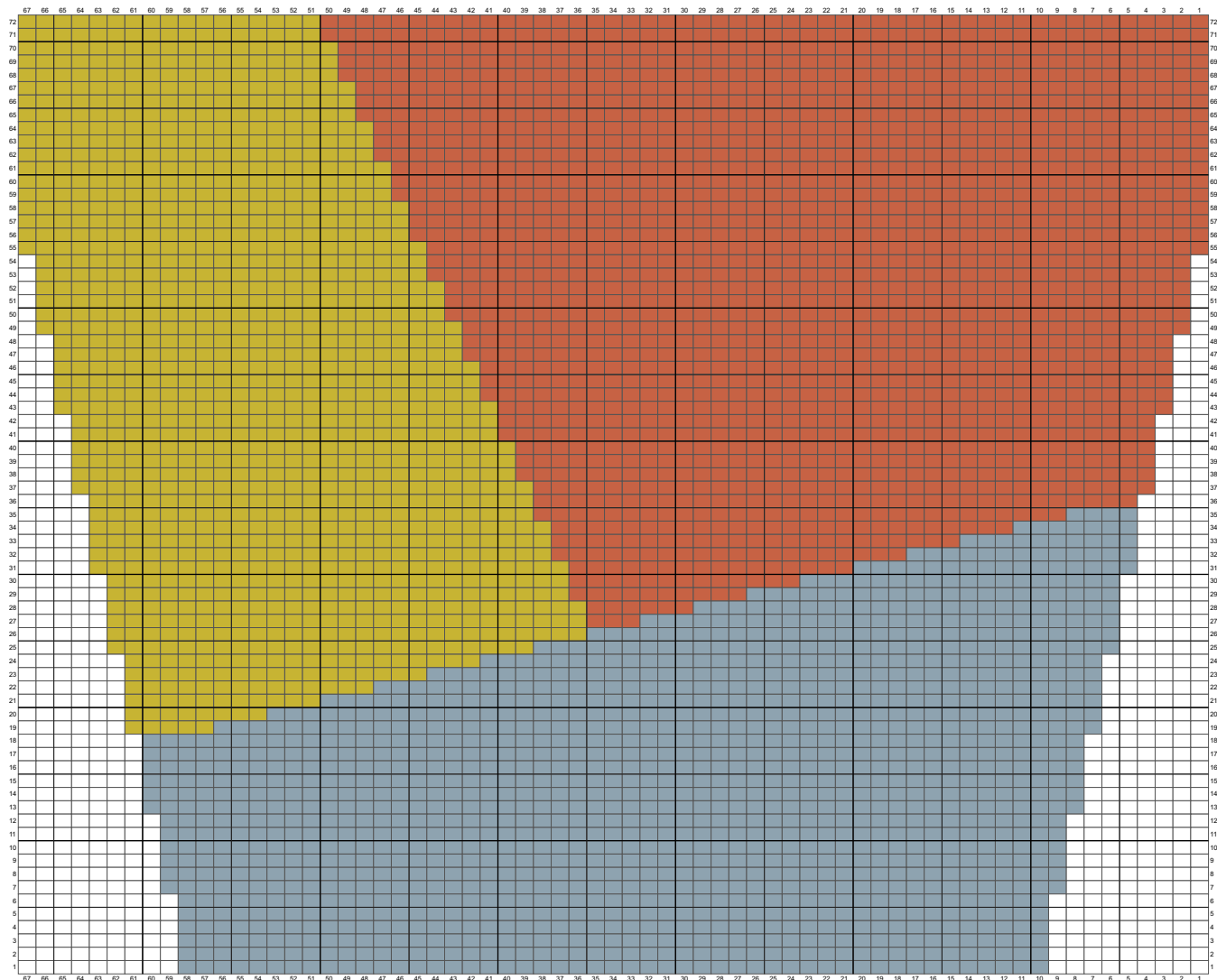

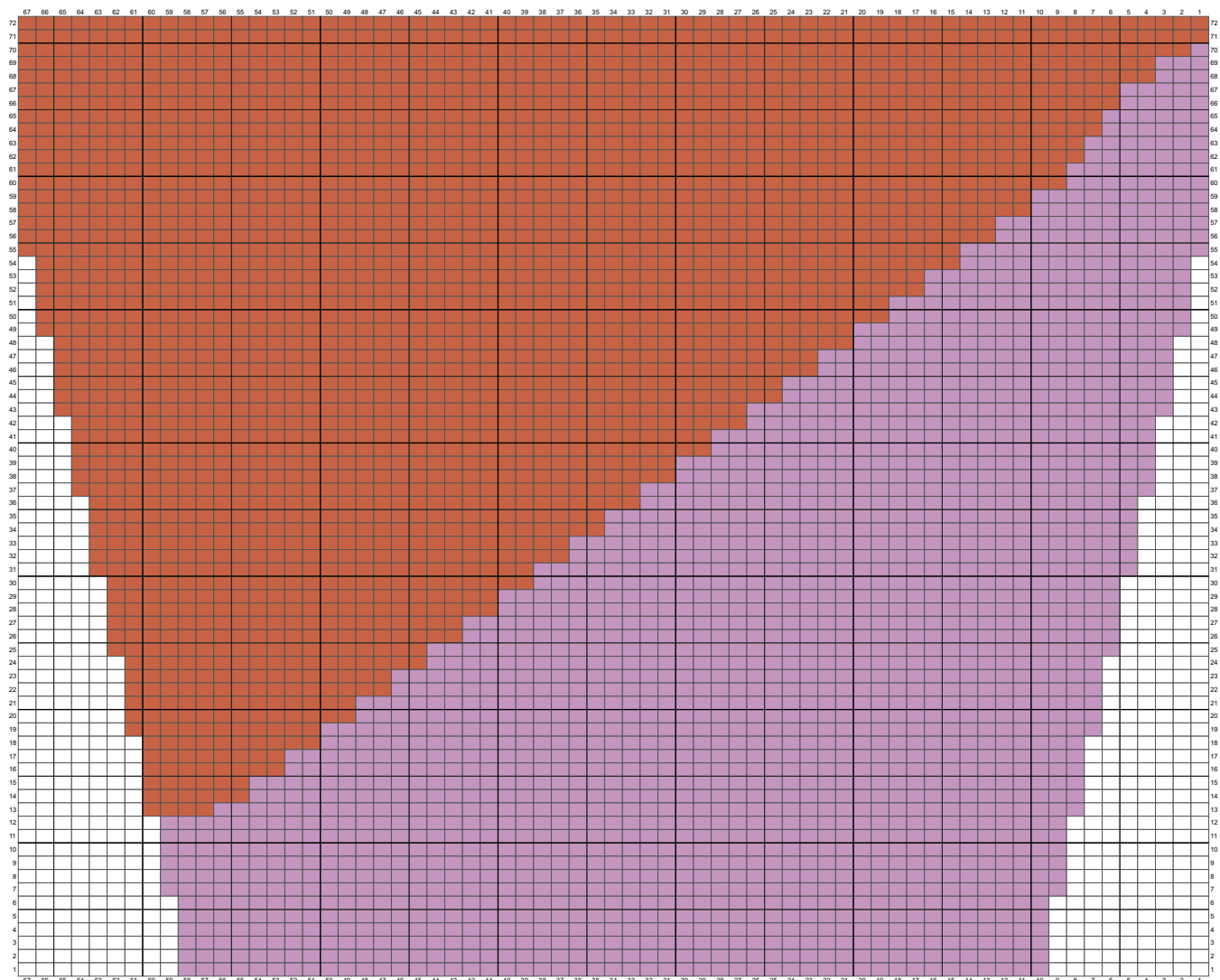
