



## Sybil Scarf

*SIZE*

Approx. 14" wide x 61" long

*MATERIALS*

Manos del Uruguay FINO (70% extrafine merino, 30% silk; approx. 100g / 490 yds), 1 sk MC plus 1 Mini-Skein Kit.

Shown in 456 Malachite (MC) with #16 Sybil [444 Topsy Turvy (CC3), 424 Gilt (CC2), 443 Turkish Delight (CC1), 431 Chemise (CC4), 425 Fascinator (CC5)].

US 5 / 3.75mm circular needle, 24" or longer, or size to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

*GAUGE*

22 sts = 4" over Stockinette St, after blocking

*ABBREVIATIONS*

CC: contrast color

k: knit

MC: main color

p: purl

patt: pattern

rep: repeat(s), repeating

RS: right side

st(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

*INSTRUCTIONS*

With CC1, cast on 350 sts. Knit 2 rows. Work a stripe as follows:

Rows 1-3: Knit.

Row 4 (WS): K2, p to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: Rep Row 4.

Rows 7-9: Knit.

Rows 10 and 12: Rep Row 4.

Row 11: Knit.

Rows 13 and 14: Knit.

Break yarn at end of Row 14.

Stripe 2: Join MC and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 3: Join CC2 and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 4: Join MC and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 5: Join CC3 and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 6: Join MC and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 7: Join CC4 and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 8: Join MC and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 9: Join CC5 and rep rows 1-14.

Stripe 10: Join MC and rep rows 1-14; do not break yarn at end of Row 14. Knit 2 rows, then bind off knitwise.

*FINISHING*

Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.
