*Do you know the fisherman stitch? It is one of those stitches that are as simple as they are beautiful. In the Fisherman Vest it shares the spotlight with our Alegria yarn, together they generate a fabric with drape and movement that accompany the freshness of the new colors of our summer-spring 2024 season.*

## Finished Measurements

Sizes - 1, (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8)

Bust circumference - 34.5 (38, 41, 44, 47, 50, 53.5, 56.5)" / 88 (96, 104, 112, 120, 128, 136, 144) cms

Shown in size 2 with 4.5" / 12 cms of ease.



## Yarn

Alegria by Manos del Uruguay. (75% superwash merino, 25% polyamide), approx. 445 yds / 405 mts per 100 g.

Color A (Pink Lemonade): 1, (1, 2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) skeins.

Color B (Litchi): 3, (3, 4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) skeins



## Needles and Tools

- One pair of straight or circular needles in size 3,0 mm / #2,5 US.  
(Or size to obtain gauge)
- 1 tapestry needle.



## Gauge

24 sts and 50 rows = 4" [10 cm] in fisherman stitch, after blocking.

## Abbreviations

K- Knit.

P- Purl.

wyib: with yarn in back.

wyif: with yarn in front.

k1b- Knit one below.

RS- Right Side.

WS- Wrong Side.

St/Sts- Stitch/Stitches.

W&T: Wrap and turn.

## Instructions

This vest will be worked in a straight knitting, so we will knit front and back separately, then we will sew both parts by sides and shoulders.

### BACK

With color A (Pink Lemonade) cast on 105, (125, 145, 165, 185, 205, 225, 245). Six stitches, for i-cord are included.

**Setup row:** P3, (k1, p1) until 4 last sts., k1, slip 3 sts wyif.

Then work the follows two rows until piece measures 8" (20 cms) from the cast on edge.

**Row 1 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, (P1, k1b) repeat until 4 last sts., p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, (k1b, p1) repeat until 4 last sts., k1b, slip 3 sts wyif.

Then change to color B (Litchi) and continue working on these two rows until piece measures 12" (30 cms) from the cast on edge.

### Armhole Shape

From here we will begin to make the decreases that will shape the armhole, as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, (k1b, p1) repeat until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, k1b, p1, (p1, k1b) repeat until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 3 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, p1, k1b, (k1b, p1) repeat until 6 last sts., (k1b) x2, p1, slip 3 sts wyib..

**Row 4:** Same as row 2

**Row 5:** Same as row 3

**Row 6:** Same as row 2

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, (p1, k1b) repeat until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 8 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, (k1b, p1) repeat until 4 last sts., k1b, slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 9 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, p1, (k1b, p1) repeat until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyib..

**Row 10:** Same as row 8

**Row 11:** Same as row 9

**Row 12:** Same as row 8

Repeat these 12 rows 11 (12, 13, 13, 14, 14, 15, 15) times in total, until we have 61 (77, 93, 113, 129, 149, 165, 185 ) stitches on my needle.



## Back Neckline and Shoulders

Keep on holding 10 (13, 13, 17, 19, 21, 25, 27 ) sts from each shoulders.

Bind off with an i-cord, 41 (51, 67, 79, 91, 107, 115, 131) centre sts. from the back neck as follow:

Cast on 3 extra stitches on the left needle, \*k2, slip 1 sts knitwise, k1, pass slip sts onto knit stitch, put the stitches onto the left needle, repeat from \*

- Pick up left shoulder stitches (from left to right with right side facing you), work as follow:

**Row 1 (RS):** knit

**Row 2 (WS):** purl

**Bind o ffrow.**

- Repeat the same for right shoulder stitches.

## FRONT

With color A (Pink Lemonade) cast on 105, (125, 145, 165, 185, 205, 225, 245). Six stitches, for i-cord are included.

: P3, (k1, p1) until 4 last sts., k1, slip 3 sts wyif.

Then work the following two rows until the piece measures 8" (20 cms) from the cast on edge.

**Row 1 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, (P1, k1b) repeat until 4 last sts., p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, (k1b, p1) repeat until 4 last sts., k1b, slip 3 sts wyif.

Then change to color B (Litchi) and continue working on these two rows until piece measures 12" (30 cms) from the cast on edge.

## Front Armhole Shape

From here we will begin to make the decreases that will shape the armhole, as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, (k1b, p1) repeat until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, k1b, p1, (p1, k1b) repeat until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 3 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, p1, k1b, (k1b, p1) repeat until 6 last sts., (k1b) x2, p1, slip 3 sts wyib..

**Row 4:** Same as row 2

**Row 5:** Same as row 3

**Row 6:** Same as row 2

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, (p1, k1b) repeat until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 8 (WS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** P3, (k1b, p1) repeat until 4 last sts., k1b, slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 9 (RS) Fisherman stitch (+ i-cord):** K3, p1, (k1b, p1) repeat until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyib..

**Row 10:** Same as row 8

**Row 11:** Same as row 9

**Row 12:** Same as row 8

Repeat these 12 rows 8 (9, 10, 10, 11, 11, 12, 12) times in total, until we have 73 (89, 105, 125, 141, 161, 177, 197 ) stitches on my needle.

## Front Armhole and Neckline Shape

From here we will shape the front neckline.

This will be worked using short rows, working first one half of the neckline, and then the other.

### Left Side Neckline Shape - Short Rows

We will work on first 26 (31, 39, 45, 51, 59, 63, 71) sts. only.

FOR SIZES 1, 2 AND 3 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., W&T

**Row 2 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 3 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 4:** same as row 2

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 2

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 8 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 9 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 10:** same as row 8

**Row 11:** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 12:** same as row 8

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 14 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 15 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 16:** same as row 14

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 14

### Front Left Shoulder

Continue working only in the 10 (13, 13, ..., ..., ..., ...) left shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the 4 (7, 7, ..., ..., ..., ...) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 20 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 21 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the 4 (7, 7, ..., ..., ..., ...) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 22:** same as row 20

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** same as row 20

Repeat these last 6 rows two more times.

Keep the shoulder and the left half neckline stitches on hold and continue working the right

neckline, armhole and shoulder.

FOR SIZES 4, 5 AND 6 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., W&T

**Row 2 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 3 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 4:** same as row 2

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 2

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 8 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 9 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 10:** same as row 8

**Row 11:** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 12:** same as row 8

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 14 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 15 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before

the last turn, W&T.

**Row 16:** same as row 14

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 14

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 20 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 21 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 22:** same as row 20

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** same as row 20

### Front Left Shoulder

Continue working only in the ... (... , ..., 17, 19, 21, ..., ...) left shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the ... (... , ..., 11, 13, 15, ..., ...) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 26 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 27 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the ... (... , ..., 11, 13, 15, ..., ...) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 28:** same as row 26

**Row 29:** same as row 27

**Row 30:** same as row 26

Repeat these las 6 rows one more times.

Keep the shoulder and the left half neckline

stitches on hold and continue working the right neckline, armhole and shoulder.

FOR SIZES 7 AND 8 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., W&T

**Row 2 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 3 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 4:** same as row 2

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 2

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 8 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 9 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 10:** same as row 8

**Row 11:** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 12:** same as row 8

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 14 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 15 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 16:** same as row 14

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 14

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 20 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 21 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T.

**Row 22:** same as row 20

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** same as row 20

### Front Left Shoulder

Continue working only in the ... (... , ... , ... , ... , ... , 63, 71) left shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** K3, p1, slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the ... (... , ... , ... , ... , ... , 25, 27) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 26 (WS):** continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts., slip 3 sts wyif.

**Row 27 (RS):** K3, continue working in fisherman stitch as work, only for the ... (... , ... , ... , ... , ... , 25, 27) stitches from the left shoulder

**Row 28:** same as row 26

**Row 29:** same as row 27

**Row 30:** same as row 26

- Repeat these last 6 rows one more times.

- Keep the left shoulder and the left half neckline stitches on hold and continue working the right neckline, armhole and shoulder.

### Right Side Neckline Shape - Short Rows

We will work on first 27 (32, 40, 46, 52, 60, 64, 72) sts. only.

FOR SIZES 1, 2 AND 3 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the end, W&T .

**Row 3 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 4:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T .

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 4

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 8 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 9 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 10:** same as row 8

**Row 11:** same as row 9

**Row 12:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 14 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 15 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 16:** same as row 14

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 14

### Front Right Shoulder

Continue working only in the 10 (13, 13, ..., ..., ..., ..., ...) right shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 20 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch until the end.

**Row 21 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 22:** same as row 20

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** same as row 20

Repeat these las 6 rows two more times.

Place the left shoulder and neck stitches back on the needle. We will bind o ffall the stitches with an i-cord as follow:

With the RS facing us, cast on 3 extra stitch on the left needle, \*k2, slip 1 sts knitwise, k1, pass slip sts onto knit stitch, put the stitches onto the

left needle, repeat from \*

While we make the i-cord bind o ffwe will have to close the wrapped stitches of the short rows, see the video reference below.

FOR SIZES 4, 5 AND 6 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the end, W&T .

**Row 3 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 4:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T .

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 4

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 8 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 9 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 10:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last

turn, W&T

**Row 11:** same as row 9

**Row 12:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 14 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 15 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 16:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 16

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 20 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 21 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 22:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

## Right Left Shoulder

Continue working only in the ... (... , ..., 17, 19, 21, ..., ...) right shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 26 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch until the end.

**Row 27 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 28:** same as row 26

**Row 29:** same as row 27

**Row 30:** same as row 26

Repeat these last 6 rows one more times.

Place the left shoulder and neck stitches back on the needle. We will bind off all the stitches with an i-cord as follow:

With the RS facing us, cast on 3 extra stitch on the left needle, \*k2, slip 1 sts knitwise, k1, pass slip sts onto knit stitch, put the stitches onto the left needle, repeat from \*

While we make the i-cord bind off we will have to close the wrapped stitches of the short rows, see the video reference below.

FOR SIZES 7 AND 8 ONLY:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 2 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the end, W&T .

**Row 3 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 4:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T .

**Row 5:** same as row 3

**Row 6:** same as row 4

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 8 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 9 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 10:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 3 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 11:** same as row 9

**Row 12:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts knitwise, slip 1 sts below, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 14 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 15 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 16:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 2 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 17:** same as row 15

**Row 18:** same as row 16

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 20 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 21 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 22:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

**Row 23:** same as row 21

**Row 24:** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch as the work until 1 sts before the last turn, W&T

### **Right Left Shoulder**

Continue working only in the ... (... , ... , ... , ... , ... , ... , 63, 71) right shoulder stitches as follows:

**Decrease row (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 6 last sts., slip 1 sts below, slip 1 sts knitwise, knit both together through the back loop, p1, slip 3 sts wyib.

**Row 26 (WS):** P3, continue working in fisherman stitch until the end.

**Row 27 (RS):** Start the row working on fisherman stitch as the work until 3 last sts, slip 3 sts wyib

**Row 28:** same as row 26

**Row 29:** same as row 27

**Row 30:** same as row 26

Repeat these last 6 rows one more times.

Place the left shoulder and neck stitches back on the needle. We will bind off all the stitches with an i-cord as follow:

With the RS facing us, cast on 3 extra stitch on the left needle, \*k2, slip 1 sts knitwise, k1, pass slip sts onto knit stitch, put the stitches onto the left needle, repeat from \*

While we make the i-cord bind off we will have to close the wrapped stitches of the short rows, see the video reference below.

## FINISHING:

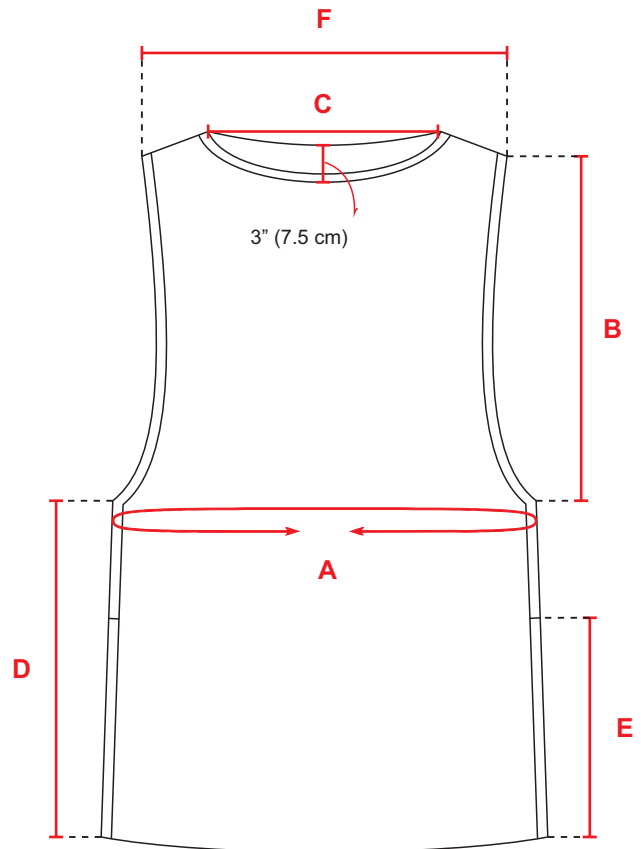
After finishing the front and back pieces we will join them:

- front shoulders and back shoulders with a crochet chain (color B yarn)
- Front and back sides with a crochet chain, this seam will be done from the beginning of color B to the beginning of the armhole shape. (color A yarn)

Weave in ends. Steam- or wet-block piece to finished measurements.

## MEASURES

It is important to keep in mind that the following measurements were taken after the garment was blocked.



### A- Bust circumference / Hem

#### circumference (no side shaping)

34.5 (38, 41, 44, 47, 50, 53.5, 56.5)"

88 (96, 104, 112, 120, 128, 136, 144) cms

### B- Armhole depth

10.5 (11.5, 12, 12, 13.5, 13.5, 14, 14)"

26.5 (29, 31, 31, 33.5, 33.5, 36, 36) cms

### C- Neck Width

6.5 (8, 11, 13, 15, 17.5, 19, 21.5)"

17 (21, 28, 33, 38, 44.5, 48, 54.5) cms

### D- Body length to underarm

13.5" / 34.5 cms

### E- Side opening

5" / 13 cms

### F- Shoulder width

12 (12.2, 12.5, 13, 13.5, 14, 14.5, 15)"

30 (31, 32, 33, 34.5, 35.5, 36.5, 37.5) cms
