MANOS DEL URUGUAY

SIZE

Women's Medium (length 19cm / 7.5", circumference 17cm / 6.75")

MATERIALS

Manos Del Uruguay Silk Blend Fino (70% Extra Fine Merino / 30% Silk), 450m/490yds per 100g),

1 x 100g hanks

Shown in #419 Brass Button

Note: 1 x 100g skein of Manos Silk Blend Fino will make both a pair of mitts and a matching Martine Hat

4mm (US #6) double pointed needle, or size to obtain tension

3.25mm (US #3) double pointed needle

Ring markers

Stitch Holders

TENSION

24 sts in 10cm over St. Johns Wort stitch in larger needles

ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off

K: knit

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together (1 stitch decreased)

m1L: make 1 left. An increase. From the front, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into back of loop

m1R: make 1 right. An increase. From the back, lift loop between stitches with left needle, knit into front of loop

P: purl

Pm: place marker

Sl: slip

Rep: repeat

st(s): stitch(es)

Yo: yarnover (1 stitch increased)

STITCH GUIDE

St. John's Wort Stitch (multiple of 5 sts)

Rnds 1 and 2: *p1, k3, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: *p1, slip 1 knitwise with yarn in back, k2, pass slipped st over 2 knit sts, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: *p1, k1, yo, k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep these 4 rnds for pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

With smaller needle, CO 44 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts, and place marker to show beginning of rnd. Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 7 rounds. Change to larger ndls.

Next rnd: *p1, k1, yo, k1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. [55 sts]

Work 23 rnds in St. John's Wort pattern, thus ending having just worked Rnd 3.

Establish thumb gusset

Next row: P1, pm, m1R, k2, m1L, pm, p1; cont in St. John's Wort patt as established for Rnd 4 to end of rnd. [57 sts]

Next rnd: P1, slm, k to next m, slm, p1; cont in St. John's Wort patt to end of rnd.

Next rnd (inc): P1, slm, m1R, k to next m, m1L, slm, p1; cont in St. John's Wort patt to end of rnd. [2 sts increased]

Rep last 2 rnds until there are 22 sts between markers, thus ending having just work Rnd 3 of pattern.

Next rnd: P1, remove m, k1, place next 20 sts on holder, yo, k1, remove m, p1; cont in patt to end of rnd. [55 sts]

Cont to work even in patt as established for 8 rnds more, thus ending having just worked Rnd 4. Change to smaller dpn and work in k1, p1 ribbing, decreasing 1 st at end of rnd. [54 sts] Work 2 more rnds in ribbing, then BO in rib.

Thumb

Place held sts on smaller dpn. Rejoin yarn and pick up 2 sts from edge of hand, then k to end of rnd. [22 sts] Work 5 rnds in k1, p1 ribbing, then BO in rib.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
